

#### GETTING STARTED

- 1. Make sure the power switch is in the off position.
- Plug the small end of the USB-C charging cable into the power input port on the Travel Keyboard and plug the other end of the cable into a power adapter (not included) or powered USB port.
- 3. Wait for the Travel Keyboard to fully charge. The battery status light will turn off.
- 4. Unplug the Travel Keyboard from the power source.
- 5. Flip the power switch to the on position. The keyboard status light will turn off in three seconds.
- 6. Press the connector button. The keyboard status light will start to blink slowly.
- On your PC, smartphone, or tablet, enter the settings, enter wireless settings or connections, and then turn on Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> wireless.
- Select "Bluetooth Keyboard" in the device menu. The keyboard status light will turn off when pairing is successful.

#### TIPS

- Compatible with Android 3.0, iOS 4.0, Windows XP, and newer versions of each.
- Computers, tablets, and smartphones must be equipped with Bluetooth wireless technology to connect to the Travel Keyboard. Uses Bluetooth 3.0 to connect wirelessly from a distance of up to 32 feet (10 meters).
- Fold the Travel Keyboard to pack easily for use on the go.
- Once paired with a device, the Travel Keyboard will automatically reconnect when powered on as long as Bluetooth is still enabled on the paired device.
- To wake the Travel Keyboard from sleep mode, press any key and wait 3 seconds. It will enter sleep mode to preserve battery life after 10 minutes of inactivity.

#### MAINTAINING BATTERY HEALTH

- Your Travel Keyboard is designed with a lithium polymer battery (non-replaceable) for cordless convenience, increased operating duration per charge, and frequent use and recharging.
- To maintain charge capacity and prevent battery damage, all lithium polymer batteries must be regularly used and recharged.
- All batteries naturally lose charge when not in use. If you will not be using the Travel Keyboard for an extended period, check the Travel Keyboard at least every 30 days to ensure the battery is at approximately 50% state of charge. Recharge as needed to maintain a 50% state of charge.
- IMPORTANT: Do NOT store the battery for an extended period with above 66% or below 33% state of charge. An incorrect state of charge during storage could irreparably damage the battery and may result in reduced charge capacity, inability to maintain charge, failure to recharge, or complete inoperability of the Travel Keyboard.
- For the health of the battery, always store the Travel Keyboard in a cool, dry place. The storage location should have a consistent temperature between 40°F and 70°F (5°C and 20°C) as well as a relative humidity at 70% or lower.


