To Whom It May Concern:


The referenced device is an updated version of a previously approved emergency-use cellular telephone. The original model only had the capability to communicate with emergency centers by dialing 9-1-1. The referenced device also has this capability, but also to a response center via a "1-800" network. Location information is provided by an internal GPS receiver which does not affect compliance.

The referenced device would normally not be placed against the ear, as it would be typically operated as a "speaker phone" and held at some distance from the main torso of the human body. Nevertheless, the device does meet the "worst case" criteria for a device that is held to the ear. Therefore, we have elected to submit this unit under the TNE classification.

Please note that the FCC Id: Label Placement Photos show an erroneous FCC Identifier; however, the placement location remains representative for this purpose. The exhibit of the actual label drawing does show the correct FCC Identifier.
