- Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in death or serious injury.

PANTONE 3252 C

- **NEVER** let the child sleep in this product while in bouncer mode. Babies have suffocated when bouncers have been used as a sleep product.
- Remove plastic wrapper before using the product. This should be destroyed or kept away from babies and children.
- Always ensure Elvie Rise is placed on a stable, firm, horizontal, flat, dry and clear floor, away from anything that may obstruct its movement before use.
- Never use this product on an **elevated** surface (e.g. a table, worktop), an **inclined** surface, a **soft** surface (e.g. a bed, sofa, cushion) or on top of any other product.
- ALWAYS ensure that Elvie Rise is locked into a mode before use. If Elvie Rise is turned on and not locked into mode, the light will ripple red.

- DO NOT use the product if any parts are broken, damaged, torn, loose or missing, or when any fabric elements such as the side wall or padded sheet are removed.
- Regularly examine the charging cable for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts. Do not use if there is any damage to the parts.
- The product shall only be used with the recommended transformer.
- Do not use accessories or replacement parts other than those intended for use with Flyie Rise.
- DO NOT allow other children to play unsupervised near the product and avoid sibling control of the product.
- DO NOT use the product with more than one child at a time.
- DO NOT use this product near flaming objects.
- ALLERGIES: DO NOT use if baby has known

adverse reactions to polyester, spandex or bamboo fibre. If your baby shows signs of an allergic reaction to these fabrics when using Elvie Rise, discontinue use.

- HEALTH CONDITIONS & INJURIES: consult your pediatrician before using SootheLoop™ or manual bouncing modes if your baby has a health condition, is recovering from an injury, or is generally unwell.
- PACEMAKERS: This product contains a magnet which makes Flyie Rise unsuitable for users with pacemakers.

CAUTION: Electrically-operated product

As with all electrical products, precautions should be observed during handling and use to prevent electric shock. You should:

- STOP using if any potential hazards are identified.
- Periodically examine the product for potential hazards (for example, visible wires or defects to electrical parts) and make sure that any potentially hazardous parts are repaired or replaced.
- Only use the electrical adapter provided. Use of other electrical adaptors may permanently damage Elvie Rise and pose an electric shock hazard.








1. Intended use






3. What's in the box

Elvie Rise comes with the parts and accessories shown, as well as an integrated foam mattress and breathable inner side wall.

Tip: We recommend keeping your Elvie Rise box for future storage










4. Using Elvie Rise

4.1 Assembly

1. Unpack the small box and leave the Baby Hub where it is for now.

PANTONE 3252 C

2. Tightly screw the four legs into the base.



- 3. Place the base on a stable, flat floor,
- 4. Unwrap the Baby Hub and dispose of the plastic wrapping.
- 5. Position the Baby Hub so the front is facing the same direction as the arrow on the base
- 6. Slot the Baby Hub into the base and gently push down until it locks into place.
- 7. Charge Elvie Rise by attaching the magnetic power cable to the charging port and plugging the other end into a wall socket.
- 8. Hold the button down until the light turns on. This may take a few seconds.

You're good to go. Now download the Elvie Soothe & Sleep app to get started with Elvie Rise features.



4.2 Using the Elvie Soothe & Sleep app

Download on the App Store

Download Elvie Soothe & Sleep from the App Store or Google Play Store to:

- 1. Follow step-by-step guides for using Elvie Rise
- 2 Start stop and fine-tune a bounce
- 3. See baby's time in bassinet, automatically recorded by Elvie Rise
- 4. Record baby's sleep sessions
- 5. Track sleep patterns over time
- 6. Get the latest updates

It's important to update your firmware when a new release is available so your Elvie Rise performs at its best.

4.3 Securing baby in the bouncer

△ WARNING

ALWAYS ensure baby is clothed to avoid the harness rubbing against their bare skin.

- 1. Ensure Flyie Rise is in either newborn or infant bouncer mode. If it's not. please follow the instructions in 4.5 Transitioning between modes.
- If the harness is retracted, pull it out from the harness slot until it comes to a natural stop.
- 3. Place baby gently into the bouncer. Their bum should be on the 'e' marked on the padded sheet.
- . If Elvie Rise is in standby mode and is charged or charging, the lights above the button will automatically turn on.
- Continue to ensure baby stays in the seated position while you attach the harness.



- 6. Unfold the harness and check it's not twisted. You'll see the Elvie logo at the front when it's positioned correctly.
- 7. Align the harness buckles with the clips on each side of the bouncer and push until you hear them 'click' into place.
- 8. Adjust the harness so it fits snugly and push the poppers into place, making sure they're securely fastened on both sides. The inner poppers are for smaller babies and the outer poppers are for larger babies.
- 9. Check the harness is fully secured by gently pulling it towards you.

To remove baby:

- Make sure the bouncer has stopped.
- 2. Push the button in the middle of each harness buckle to release the harness.
- 3. Hold baby in place while you move the harness out of the way.
- 4. Lift baby out of the seat.

4.4 Using Elvie Rise as a bouncer

△ WARNING

- **NEVER** let the child sleep in this product while in bouncer mode. This product is not safe for sleep or unsupervised use when in bouncer mode. Stay near and watch baby during use.
- Never leave the child unattended.
- Do not move or lift this product with the baby inside it.
- ALWAYS ensure Elvie Rise is placed on a stable, firm, horizontal, flat, dry and clear floor, away from anything that may obstruct its movement before use.

△ WARNING

FALL Hazard: Babies have suffered skull fractures. falling while in and from bouncers.

- Use bouncer ONLY on floor.
- ALWAYS use restraints and adjust to fit snugly.
- **NEVER** lift or carry Elvie Rise while baby is inside.

SUFFOCATION Hazard: Babies have suffocated when bouncers tipped over on soft surfaces and/or when bouncers have been used as a sleep product.

- **NEVER** let the child sleep in this product while in bouncer mode. This product is not safe for sleep or unsupervised use when in bouncer mode. Stay near and watch baby during use.
- If baby falls asleep in bouncer mode, transition the product into bassinet mode immediately. or remove baby as soon as possible and place baby on a firm, flat sleep surface such as a crib or bassinet.
- NEVER use on a bed, sofa, cushion, or other soft surface.

To prevent falls and suffocation:

• ALWAYS secure the harness and adjust to fit snugly.







ONLY use Elvie Rise on a stable, flat floor.

CAUTION: Guidance differs amongst bodies regarding the appropriate length of time for a baby to use seats and bouncers, and may change from time to time - please refer to the latest guidance from your local health authority.

You can bounce Elvie Rise manually, or use SootheLoop™ technology to automate the bounce based on your own soothing rhythm.

Starting a manual bounce

- 1. Ensure baby is secure in the harness
- 2. Bounce Elvie Rise by hand at your desired level. Older babies may naturally set the bounce through their own movements

Recording a SootheLoop™ bounce

- 1. Ensure baby is secured in the harness
- 2. Press the button and gently bounce Elvie Rise by hand while the light is pulsing white
- 3. When the light turns turquoise, your bounce has been recorded and Elvie Rise will start to bounce automatically.
- To stop SootheLoop™ bouncing, press the button again.
- 5. The light will turn white and the bouncing will gently come to a stop.
- 6. SootheLoop™ bouncing will automatically stop after 30 minutes.

A full battery should give you up to 2 hours of bouncing before you need to plug it in.

Starting, stopping and fine-tuning a bounce using the Elvie Soothe and Sleep app

- 1. Ensure baby is secure in the harness.
- 2. Check your phone's Bluetooth is turned on and follow the instructions in the app to pair with Elvie Rise.
- 3. Use the in-app controls to start, stop and fine-tune a bounce.

4.5 Transitioning between modes

↑ WARNING

- If you're intending to use Elvie Rise for sleep, it must be set up in bassinet mode and baby should be positioned correctly according to safe sleep guidelines as recommended by your local health authority.
- ALWAYS ensure that Elvie Rise is locked into a mode before use. If Elvie Rise is turned on and not locked into mode, the light will ripple red.
- DO NOT transition Elvie Rise from bassinet to a bouncer mode while baby is in the Baby Hub as the harness can not be fastened. Transitioning from bassinet to bouncer mode could result in serious injury.

Transitioning from bouncer to bassinet

Tip: if this is the first time you're transitioning Elvie Rise from a bouncer to bassinet, we recommend trying it without baby in.

- 1. When Elvie Rise is in either bouncer mode, gently push down on the foot-end then squeeze and hold the transition handle before pulling up.
- 2. The light will show a white ripple effect as you transition between modes.
- 3. The harness will automatically detach and retract into the harness slot. Make sure the harness slot is clear and baby isn't blocking the harness from retracting.
- 4. Release the handle once the bassinet has fully expanded.





- 5. Push down on the grips while pulling up the sides with your other hand to lock Elvie Rise into bassinet mode.
- 6. When you hear a 'click', it's locked in.
- 7. If the light turns to a red ripple effect, it's not locked into bassinet mode and you'll need to try pulling the bassinet side up again while pushing down on the grips.
- 8. Check the harness and harness buckles are fully retracted and tucked inside the harness slot before using the bassinet. For baby's safety, the harness cannot be pulled out when in bassinet mode

Transitioning from bassinet to bouncer

- 1. Squeeze and hold the transition handle before gently pushing down on the foot-end.
- 2. For newborn bouncer, release the handle at the beginning of the transition and continue to push down until you hear it 'click' into place.
- 3. For infant bouncer, keep the handle squeezed as you push down, release when it reaches infant bouncer mode and continue to push down until you hear it 'click' into place.

Click

- 4. The light will show a white ripple effect as you transition between modes.
- 5. If the light turns to a red ripple effect, it's not locked into a bouncer mode and you'll need to try again.
- 6. To start using the bouncer, please follow the instructions in 4.3 Securing baby in the bouncer.



4.6 Adjusting between bouncer modes

△ WARNING

If you accidentally move past newborn bouncer mode into bassinet mode, the harness will automatically detach. If this happens, remove baby from Elvie Rise and transition it back into a bouncer mode.


Adjusting from infant bouncer to newborn bouncer

- Gently push down on the foot-end. squeeze the transition handle then release it as you start to pull up. Continue to pull up until you hear it 'click' into place.
- 2. If the light turns to a red ripple effect. it's not locked into a bouncer mode and you'll need to try again.
- 3. To start using the bouncer, please follow the instructions in














- Gently push down on the foot-end, squeeze the transition handle then release it and continue to push down until you hear it 'click' into place.
- 2. The light will show a white ripple effect as you move between modes.
- 3. If the light turns to a red ripple effect, it's not locked into a bouncer mode and you'll need to try again.
- 4. To start using the bouncer, please follow the instructions in **4.3 Securing baby in the bouncer**.



4.7 Sleeping in Elvie Rise

△ WARNING

- Elvie Rise is suitable for sleep when in bassinet mode only. If baby falls asleep in bouncer mode, transition the product into bassinet mode immediately, or remove baby as soon as possible and place baby on a firm, flat sleep surface such as a crib or bassinet.
- NEVER let the child sleep in this product while in bouncer mode.

- STOP using the bassinet mode as soon as baby can sit or kneel or pull itself up, or has reached the age, length or weight limitations set out in 1. Intended use, whichever comes first.
- Legs should not be folded when the product is in bassinet mode.
- DO NOT use more than one mattress in Elvie Rise.
- Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the near vicinity of the bassinet.
- Do not smoke near the product. Do not leave cigarettes in or around the product.
- Always ensure the harness is tucked away in bassinet mode to prevent entanglement or injury.
- Only use the mattress sold with Elvie Rise, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards.
- Regularly check if the mattress remains firm and flat.
- Contact Chiaro Technology for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed.
- Only use the product on a stable, flat floor.
- Young children should not play unsupervised in the vicinity of the bassinet.

△ WARNING

Failure to follow these warnings and the instructions could result in serious injury or death.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD Babies have suffocated:

- On pillows, comforters, and extra padding;
- In gaps between a wrong-size mattress, or extra padding and product sides.
- NEVER add soft bedding, sheets, padding, pillows or other such items. Placing additional items in the product may cause suffocation.
- Use ONLY with a mattress intended for Elvie Rise.

 Do not use accessories or replacement parts other than those intended for use with Elvie Rise.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome), pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

FALL HAZARD: To help prevent falls,

- Do not use this product if your baby is strong enough to start pushing up on their hands and knees, can sit, kneel, pull themselves up or is 5 months old or weighs 10kg/22lb, whichever comes first.
- DO NOT use the product if any parts are broken, damaged, torn, loose or missing.
- Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by gently pulling upwards on the transition handle before leaving child unattended.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

- Strings can cause strangulation. Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
- Keep the electric adapter cable out of reach of infants and children.

- Do not place Elvie Rise near a window or patio door where cords from blinds could present a strangulation hazard.
- Do not place the product close to another product, which could present a danger of suffocation or strangulation, e.g. strings, blind/curtain cords, etc.
- Do not place or rest the power cord inside the bassinet.

To reduce the risk of SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome), we recommend that you always use Elvie Rise in accordance with the most up-to-date safe sleep guidelines from your local health authority

These may include:

- Place the baby on his or her back on a firm sleep surface such as a crib or bassinet with a tight-fitting sheet.
- Avoid use of soft bedding, including crib bumpers, blankets, pillows and soft toys. The crib should be bare.
- Share a bedroom with parents, but not the same sleeping surface, preferably until the baby turns 1 but at least for the first six months. Room-sharing decreases the risk of SIDS by as much as 50 percent.
- · Avoid baby's exposure to smoke, alcohol and illicit drugs.

4.9 Carrying Elvie Rise

↑ WARNING

- Elvie Rise weighs 9kg/20lb. Be very careful when lifting or carrying while pregnant or postpartum.
- Do not move or lift Elvie Rise while baby is inside.
- NEVER carry baby at the same time as carrying Elvie Rise.
- Never use a toy bar or attachment to carry the product.
- Avoid holding the hinge area (where the legs fold) as moving parts may pinch your hand.
- After moving Elvie Rise, check the legs are screwed in and fully extended before use.

Elvie Rise has been designed with a collapsible base and embedded carrying groove, so you can move it easily around your home if you need.

Preparing to move Elvie Rise

- 1. Turn Elvie Rise off and remove the cable if it's charging.
- 2. Position yourself at the foot-end of the Baby Hub while Elvie Rise is in newborn or infant bouncer mode.
- 3. Using the carrying groove around the top of the Baby Hub, lift Elvie Rise towards you.
- 4. At this point, fold the back legs down towards the front legs. They'll fully collapse when Elvie Rise has been lifted off the floor.
- 5. Using the carrying groove as a handle, carry Elvie Rise in a way you find comfortable - in front of you or by your side.
- 6. Place Elvie Rise back down on a stable, flat floor.
- 7. Set the back legs on the floor and extend the front legs until Elvie Rise is stable.













4.10 Charging Elvie Rise

↑ WARNING

Do not place the charging cable in a location where it could be a trip hazard.

- 1. Attach the magnetic power cable to the port in the back of the base.
- 2. Plug the other end into a wall socket and switch on.

A full battery gives you over to 2 hours of bouncing before you need to plug it in. When the light flashes amber the battery is running low and you'll need to charge it.

4.11 Caring for Elvie Rise

△ WARNING

- You need to change or launder your padded sheet and inner side wall if they become wet or soiled.
- Never use Elvie Rise when fabric components are removed.
- Always ensure that the padded sheet and inner side wall are correctly reattached before use. The padded sheet must be attached to the velcro on the Baby Hub.
- Check that any laundered materials are fully dry before refitting to avoid mold

We recommend washing your padded sheet before first use and regularly inspecting Elvie Rise materials to check they're in a good, clean condition.

We recommend washing your padded sheet using a cold-water or ECO cycle as this is more energy efficient.

How to wash the padded sheet

- Unzip and remove the padded sheet.
- Wash on its own at 30°C/Warm Wash 90-110°E.
- Tumble dry on a low heat (~52°C/~115°F).
- 4. When completely dry, pull the harness back through the harness slot
- 5. Press down firmly on the 'e' on the padded sheet to re-attach it to the Baby Hub, and make sure the harness slot is clear.

Spare Elvie Rise padded sheets are available to buy online at elvie.com





How to wash the inner side wall

- 1. Unzip and remove the inner side wall.
- 2. Wash on its own at 30°C/Warm Wash 90-110°F
- Tumble dry on a low heat (~52°C/~115°F).
- 4. When it's completely dry, zip it back in.
- 5. If you see a gap or have difficulty zipping it back in, the inner side wall may be upside down - make sure you've aligned the coloured zip tape and try again.

Other components

The water-resistant layer under the padded sheet, outer side wall and harness can all be wiped clean as needed.





4.12 Storage, disassembly & disposal

Storing

- Before you put Elvie Rise in storage, make sure you've run the latest firmware update - you'll find it in Settings within the Elvie Soothe & Sleep app.
- When not in use, store Elvie Rise in a temperature and humidity-controlled place, between 0°C/32°F-45°C/113°F.

PANTONE 3252 C

- Before longer-term storage, clean and thoroughly dry all parts and check the original packaging for moisture or pests.
- · Fully charge before storing away and recharge every 6 months to increase the lifespan of your Elvie Rise.
- · Avoid storing in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
- · When re-assembling after storage, check all parts are attached and intact before use.

Disassembly

- 1. Put Elvie Rise into infant bouncer mode.
- 2. Reach underneath the base and press the coral button in the centre until vou hear a 'click'.
- 3. Hold the base in place and carefully lift the Baby Hub off.
- 4. Unscrew the four legs from the base.
- 5. Repack Elvie Rise in its original packaging.

Disposing

This product should not be disposed of with other household waste throughout the EU and UK. 
