PRODUCT INTRODUCTION




Remove the old wireless charging module (Different cars have different positions).







Unplug the old harness module.





Connect the harness to the adapter harness of the new module.



HOW TO WORK

When the new module is working, it still display a" lightning icon" on the screen (Different cars have different positions).
