Using your Fast Wireless Charging Pad

- Power up your Wireless Charging Pad using provided USB-C cable and power supply ONLY.
- Place your Qi-enabled device on the Wireless Charging Pad with the screen facing up.

Charging Indicator Light Status

Red flashing light: ERROR, please re-position your device



 Green light: CHARGING, lights up green, flashes 3 times and goes off (device will remain charging)
