Question #1: Page 6 of EMC test report only provide max. ERP/EIRP output power for GSM/EDGE but without WCDMA. Please incorporate WCDMA Max. output power in this table summary. Make sue to indicate the RBW used for WCDMA.

Question #2: Based upon FCC 3G policy, all 3 G module (in this case) must include detail information on the test mode. As indicated in the test report, GSM/EDGE portion were tested with specific test program provided by the manufacturers. Please indicate the program name and version number. For WCDMA, please include the communication setting from base station simulator.

Question #3:Antenna condition during the tests: As indicated in the WWAN antenna report, the antenna has two user configurable position: close and open. The antenna gain at open position has higher gain in Cellular band but at the close position, cellular band has higher gain. Per the test report, the ERP/EIRP evaluation only investigated with antenna at open (extended) position for cellular and PCS position. Please explain.
