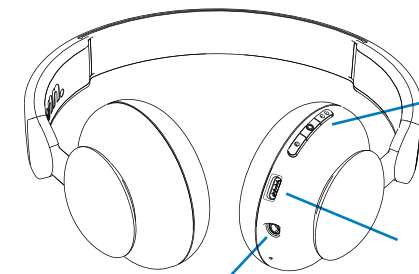

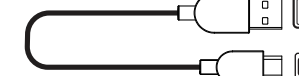

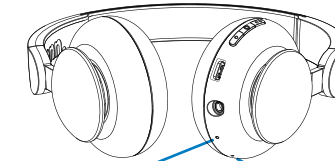

## Operation

### FIRST TIME SETUP

Device may need to be charged before use.



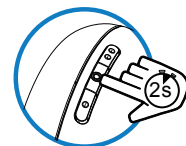
**CAUTION**  
Only use a USB  
charging device that  
is 5V DC output.

Remove the protective film before the first use, then power on the headphone and it will go to pairing mode automatically. Headphone will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when powered on next time.

### POWER ON & POWER OFF

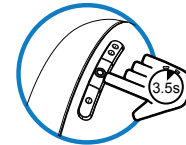
#### POWER ON

Press the multifunction button for about 2 seconds and the blue indicator flashes for 2 seconds.



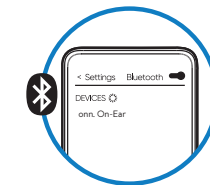
#### POWER OFF

Press the multifunction button for about 3.5 seconds and the red indicator flashes for 2 seconds.



### PAIRING

- A. If this is the first time connecting your headphones, follow FIRST TIME SETUP instructions.
- B. If you want to pair your headphones with a new device, please disconnect it from the Bluetooth list of your current device. Once disconnected, it will go to pairing mode automatically.

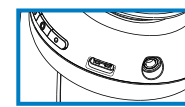

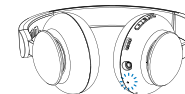
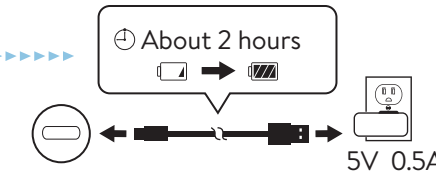
### CHARGING

#### CHARGE THE Headphones

1. It is recommended that you use the provided charging cable.
2. The headphones will automatically power off when charging. It may take up to 2 hours to get it fully charged when at 0% battery.

Fully charged: Blue LED light is on

Note: 10 mins charge can provide around 3 hours playtime.

### CLEANING

1. Wipe down surfaces with a cleaning cloth.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Prevention/Solution
<b>Cannot find "onn. On-Ear" on my Bluetooth device.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure Bluetooth function is enabled on your device.</li><li>• Double check if the headphones already connected with last-time paired device.</li></ul>
<b>Sound is not produced.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure you have headphones connected with Bluetooth device, and increase volume from your device.</li></ul>
<b>Cannot power on</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Charge headphones for enough time.</li></ul>
