I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The Manual appears to indicate that this device will have a WLAN module installed, but no WLAN information is presented on Form 731, and no WLAN exhibits are filed. Does this Point Of Sale terminal have a WLAN device?
- 2.) Is the WLAN and Part 22/24 transceiver capable of simultaneous transmission? Should this device go to FCC?
- 3.) If simultaneous transmission (co-located transmitters) is applicable, then the Manual statements prohibiting co-location must be removed.
- 4.) This device appears capable of connecting to a computer via a USB cable? Will a Class B certification or a DoFC apply? If DoFC is the desired equipment authorization, then you are reminded of the labeling requirements described in Part 2 and 15 in the FCC rules.
- 5.) Will this device be sold in Canada? If so, then an application for approval in Canada is required.
