To take advantage of these features, download or set up a Google™ account. This can be done in the setup wizard the first time you power on the tablet.

**Charging the tablet**

Connect the tablet to a wall outlet using the included AC adapter as shown below.

**Power ON / OFF**

**Turning on the tablet**  
Press and hold the On/Off button until the startup screen appears.

**Power off the tablet**  
Press & hold the On/Off button until the "Power off" option is repeated.

**Lock the tablet (standby)**  
Briefly press the On/Off button. Lock the tablet to conserve the battery.

**Unlock the tablet**  
Briefly press the On/Off button, and slide the "Lock icon" to the right.

**Battery life**

- Turn off Wi-Fi when it's not in use.
- Turn the tablet screen brightness down as shown (dragging the slider).
- To conserve battery time and performance, adjust the "Brightness" and "Screen timeout" options in the Settings app.

**Connecting**

**WiFi and Bluetooth®**

To setup Wi-Fi or connect the tablet to a Bluetooth-enabled device, slide down on the top right of the Home screen as shown below.

**Using the wireless Bluetooth® keyboard**

**Charge before you begin**

**Turning the keyboard on / off**  
Slide the switch as shown above; the indicator light will briefly turn on.

**Pairing the keyboard to the tablet**

1. Turn on the keyboard.
2. Press the "Pair" button; the Bluetooth indicator light will blink and the keyboard is ready to pair with the tablet.

**Charging the keyboard**

You can charge the Bluetooth Keyboard by connecting it with included USB cable to a PC.

**Pairing the keyboard to the tablet**

3. On the tablet, scroll up when Bluetooth, Wi-Fi or Bluetooth® is selected, and select "Bluetooth Keyboard".
4. Using the keyboard, type the password shown on the tablet and press enter.
5. After pairing successful, the tablet "Bluetooth Keyboard Connected" is displayed.

To add a widget, press and hold anywhere on the home screen, select the Widgets option as shown below.

Press and hold Widgets to place them on the Home screen.

**Micro SD card**

**Inserting a Micro SD card**

The tablet supports Micro SD cards up to 64GB (not included). To install a Micro SD card into the tablet, insert the card as shown below into the card slot and click and lock into place. To remove the Micro SD card, gently press it inward to eject.

**To connect:**

1. Connect the mini end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port of the tablet.
2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port of the TV or display.
3. Select the correct input on your TV.
4. The tablet display is now shown on your TV or display.
