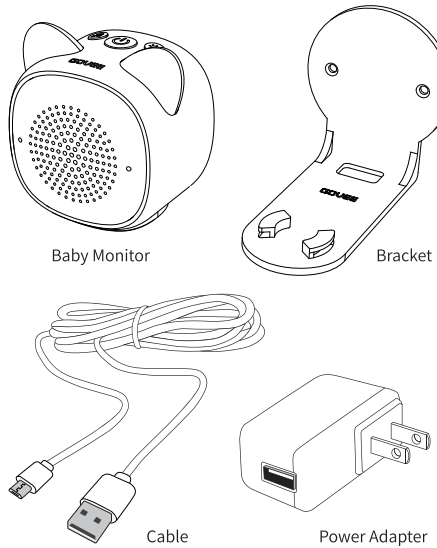

This baby monitor is compliant with all relevant standards regarding electromagnetic fields. Please read the manual carefully before using the device.

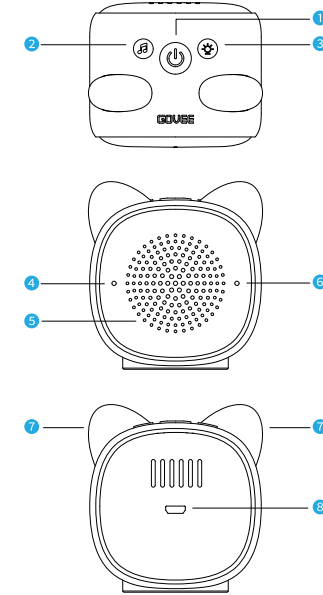
- Adult assembly is required. Keep small parts away from babies when assembling.

- This baby monitor isn't a substitute for responsible adult supervision.
- Keep the device out of the reach of babies.
- Keep cables away from babies (more than 1.64ft/0.5m away).
- Do not place the device near the water or heat source.
- Please use the power adapter provided.

1 On/Off Button:

Press to turn Baby Monitor on/off.

Press and hold for 3 seconds to get ready for connecting Wi-Fi.

2 Lullaby Button:

Press to turn on/off lullaby.

Press twice quickly to switch lullaby.

3 Night Light Button:

Press to turn the light on/off.

Press twice quickly to adjust brightness.

Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn the indicator light on/off.

4 Indicator Light:

Solid blue: Wi-Fi connection is normal.

Solid red: Lost Wi-Fi connection.

5 Speaker

6 Mic

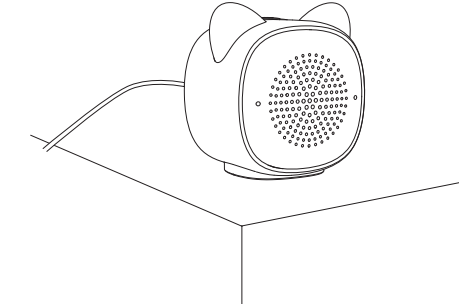

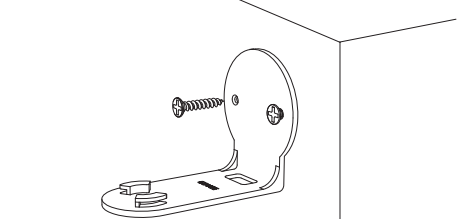

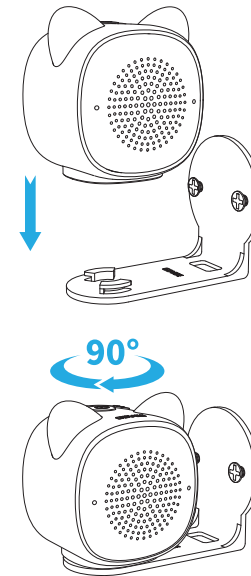
2 By the bracket

a. Install the bracket



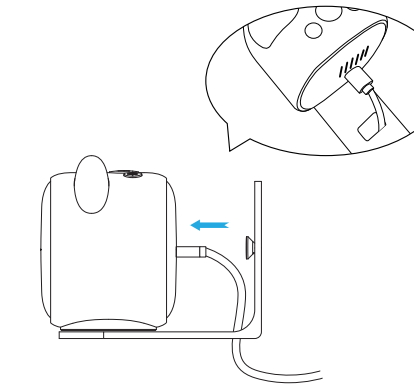

Downloading the Govee Home App

What you need:

- Download the Govee Home app from App Store (iOS devices) or Google Play (Android devices).
- A smart phone or tablet running iOS 9.3 (or above) or Android 4.3 (or above).



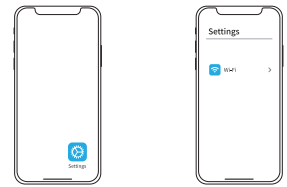
Connecting to a Wi-Fi Network

- 1 Turn on Bluetooth in your phone;



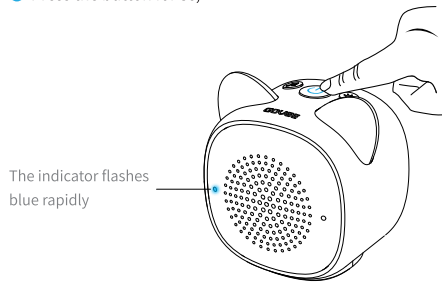

- 2 Connect your phone to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi (GPS should be turned on for Android devices);



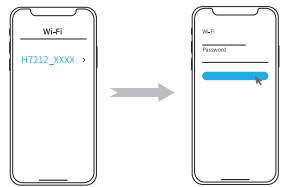
- 3 Open Govee Home, tap “+” icon at the top right corner and select “H7212”;

- 4 Press the button for 3s;

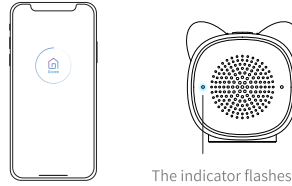

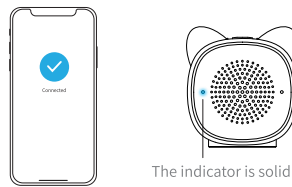
- 5 Enter Wi-Fi password;

- 7 Connect to Wi-Fi successfully.

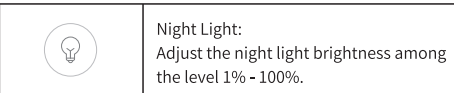
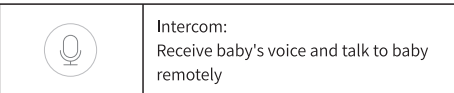
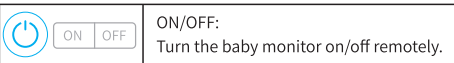

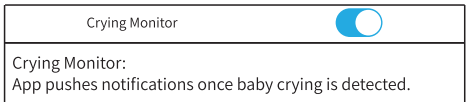
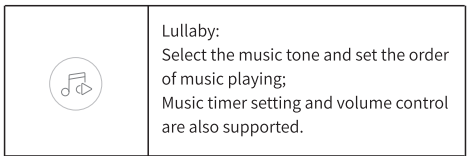
Notice:

1. Before connecting to Wi-Fi, make sure the Wi-Fi is 2.4GHz and 802.11 b/g/n bands.
2. The device stops connecting if it doesn't connect to Wi-Fi within 3 minutes.
3. The indicator turns to be solid red if Wi-Fi connection fails. Please check steps above and try again.

Using the Baby Monitor with Govee Home



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Troubleshooting

- 1 Cannot connect to Wi-Fi/Lost Wi-Fi connection.
 - a. Make sure Wi-Fi is 2.4GHz. 5GHz network is not supported.
 - b. Check whether the Wi-Fi password entered is correct.
 - c. Keep the device within router-enabled range (less than 30m/98ft is suggested).
 - d. Keep obstacles between the device and router as less as possible.
- 2 No/Delayed notification in App.
 - a. Check whether Wi-Fi connection is stable.

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- b. Make sure Govee Home is allowed in your phone.
- c. Keep the device close to the router.

- 3 Noisy audio transmission.

- a. Keep the device away from other electric appliances.
- b. Check whether the device was stably installed.
- c. More than 10ft/3m between mobile phone and the device is suggested.

- 4 No/Delayed message alert.

- a. Check whether the device is too far from your baby.
- b. Make sure the Mic of device is facing to baby.
- c. Please check whether your phone is mute or in low volume.
- d. Make sure Wi-Fi and your phone signal are stable.

- 5 The indicator doesn't work.

- a. Press the Night Light Button and hold for 3 seconds to turn it on.
- b. Re-turn on or re-plug the baby monitor.
