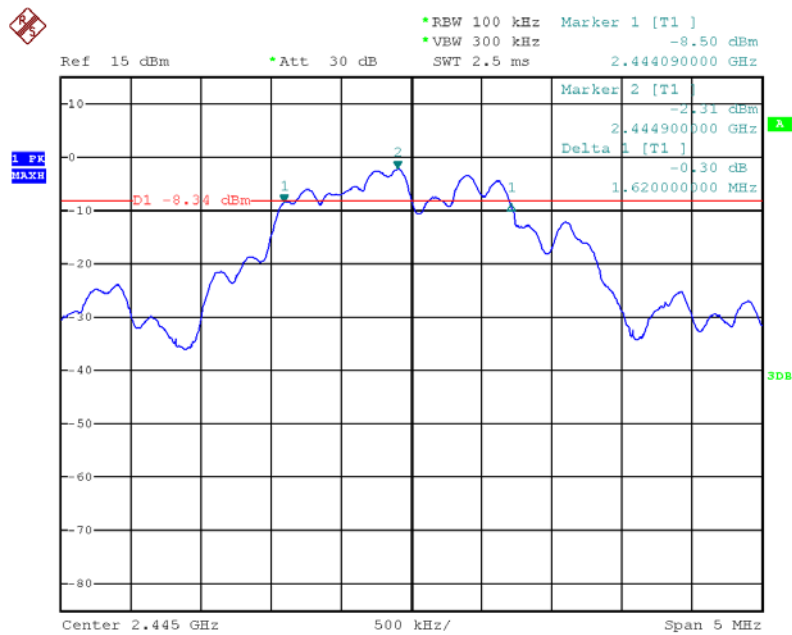

6 dB Bandwidth[MHz] Low channel (2 405 MHz)



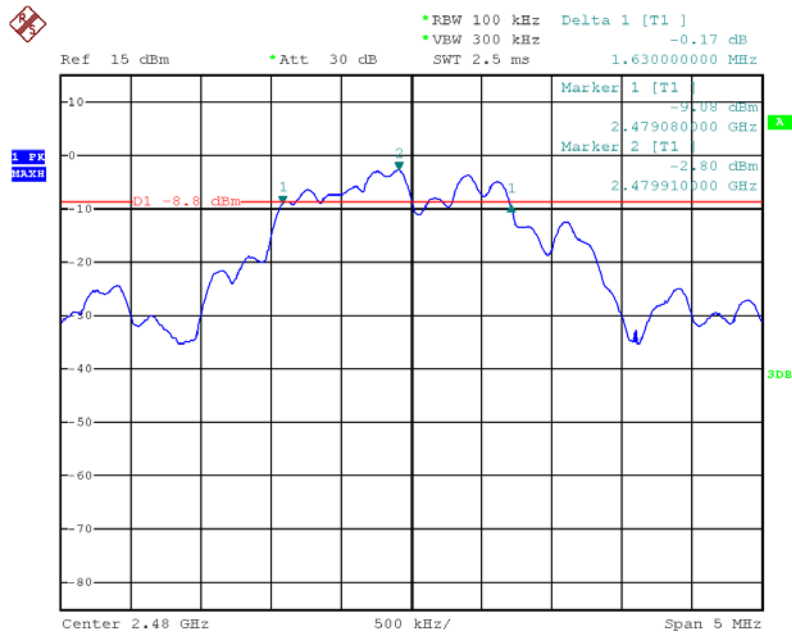

Middle channel (2 445 MHz)



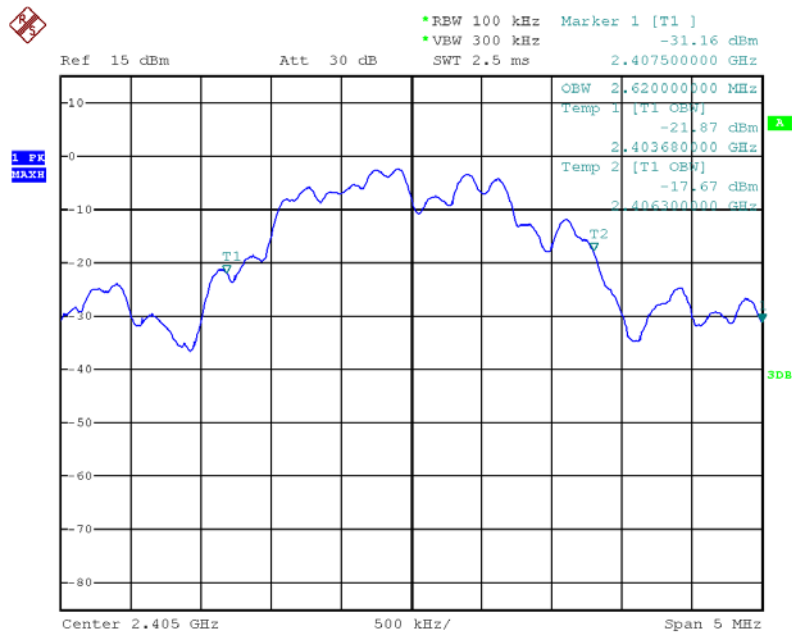

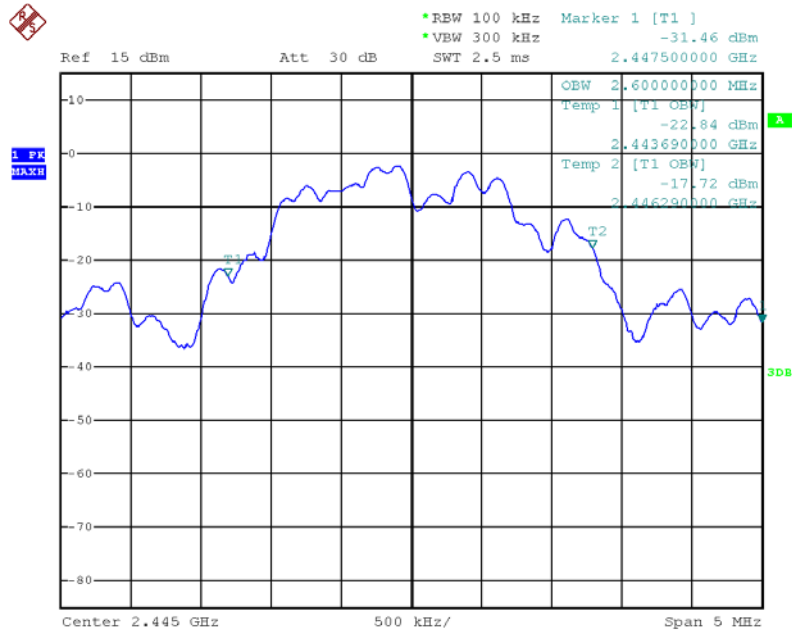

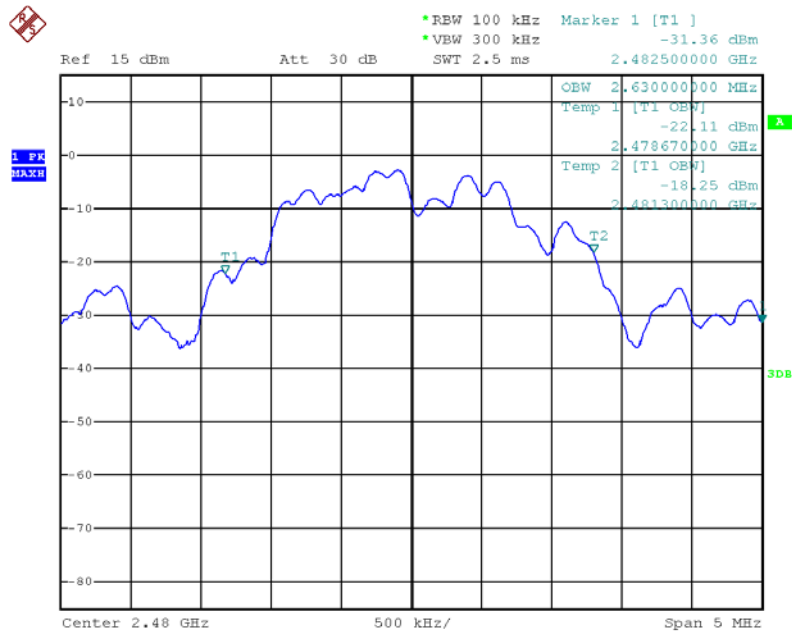

Low channel (2 405 MHz)

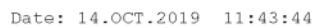
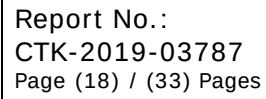

4.4 Band Edge & Conducted Spurious emission

Test Procedures(ANSI C63.10-2013 11.11.3)

The Unwanted emission from the EUT were measured according to the dictates PKPSD measurement procedure in section 11.11 of ANSI C63.10-2013.

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated device is operating, the RF power that is produced shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement, provided that the transmitter demonstrates compliance with the peak conducted power limits. If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of root-mean-square averaging over a time interval, as permitted under Section 5.4(4), the attenuation required shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. Attenuation below the general field strength limits specified in RSS-Gen is not required.

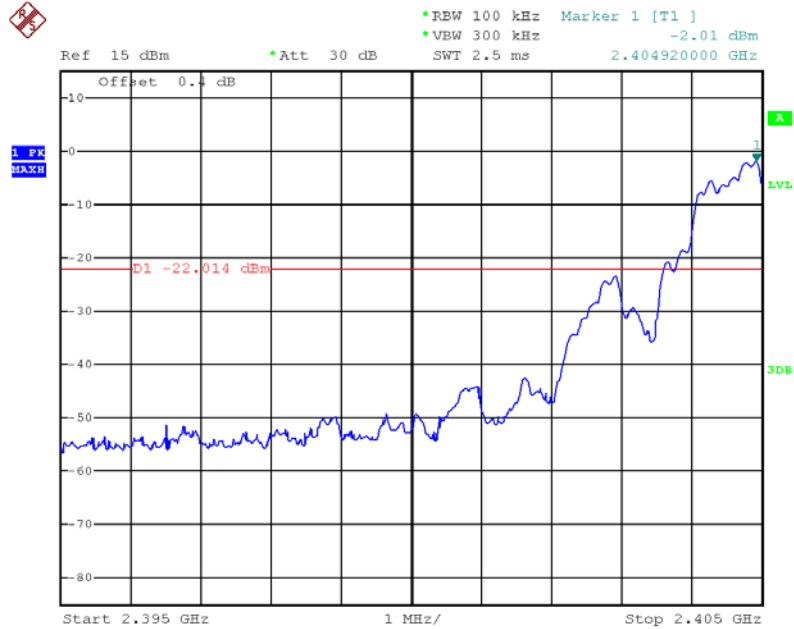

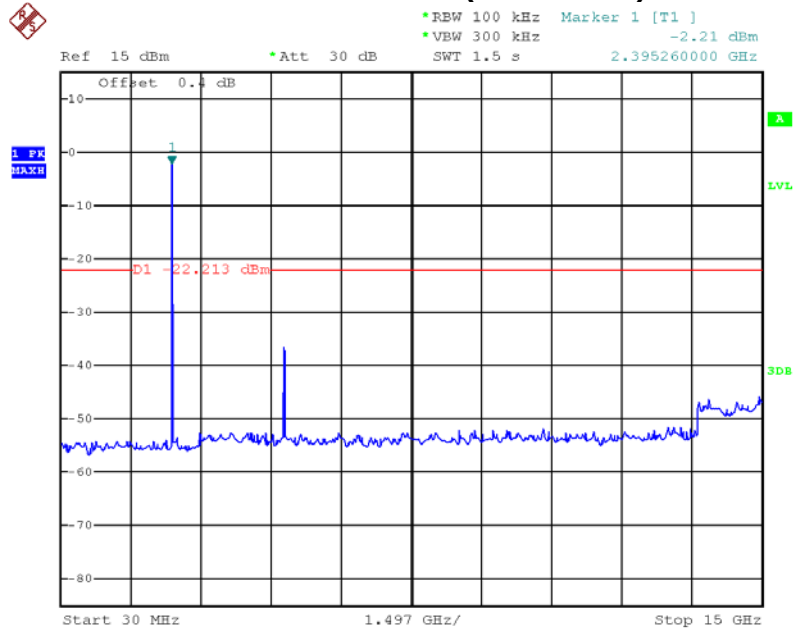
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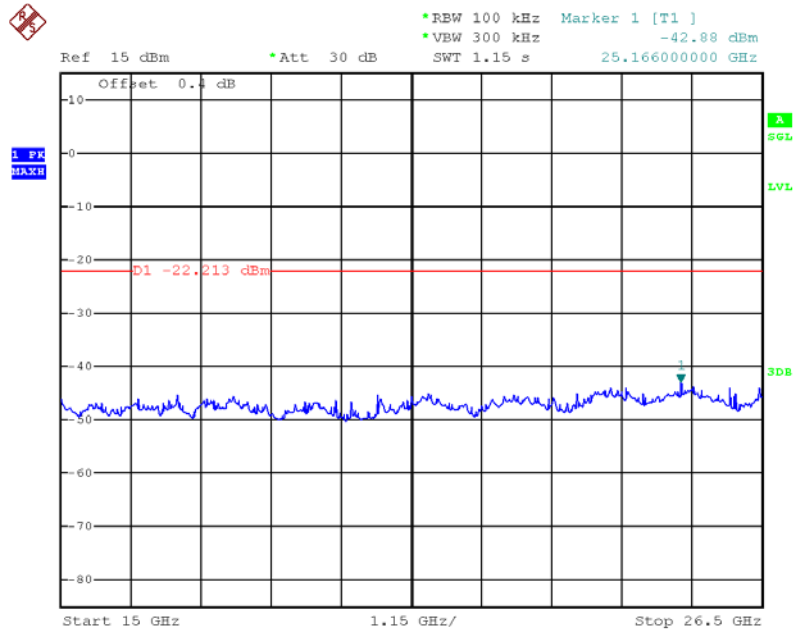

Conducted Spurious emission

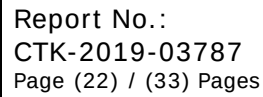
Low channel (2 405 MHz)

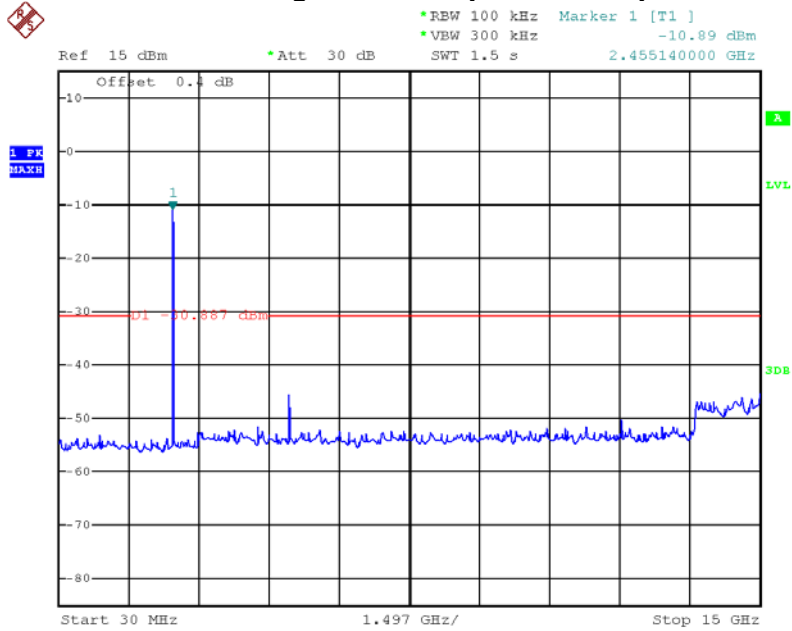

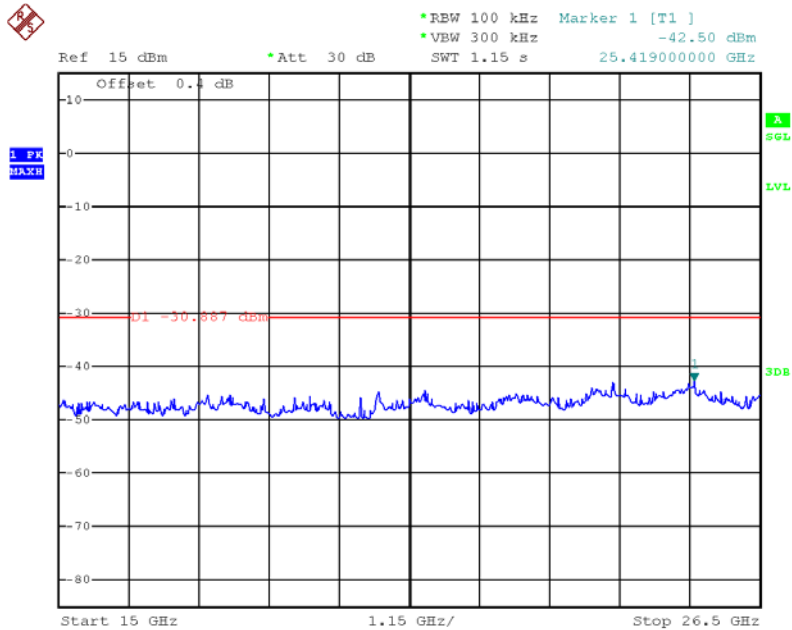

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4.5 Radiated Emission

Test Location

Test Procedures

- 1) In the frequency range of 9 kHz to 30 MHz, magnetic field is measured with Loop Antenna. The center of the Loop Test Antenna is 1m above the ground. During the measurement the Loop Test Antenna rotates about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth about the EUT.
- 2) In the frequency range above 30 MHz, Bi-Log Test Antenna(30 MHz to 1 GHz) and Horn Test Antenna(above 1 GHz) are used. Test Antenna is 3m away from the EUT. Test Antenna height is carried from 1m to 4m above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. The emissions levels at both horizontal and vertical polarizations should be tested.

§ 15.205 (b) Except as provided in paragraphs (d) and (e), the field strength of emissions appearing within these frequency bands shall not exceed the limits shown in Section 15.209. At frequencies equal to or less than 1000 MHz, compliance with the limits in Section 15.209 shall be demonstrated using measurement instrumentation employing a CISPR quasi-peak detector. Above 1000 MHz, compliance with the emission limits in Section 15.209 shall be demonstrated based on the average value of the measured emissions. The provisions in Section 15.35 apply to these measurements.

FCC Part 15 § 15.209 (a) Except as provided elsewhere in this Subpart, the emissions from an intentional radiator shall not exceed the field strength levels specified in the following table :

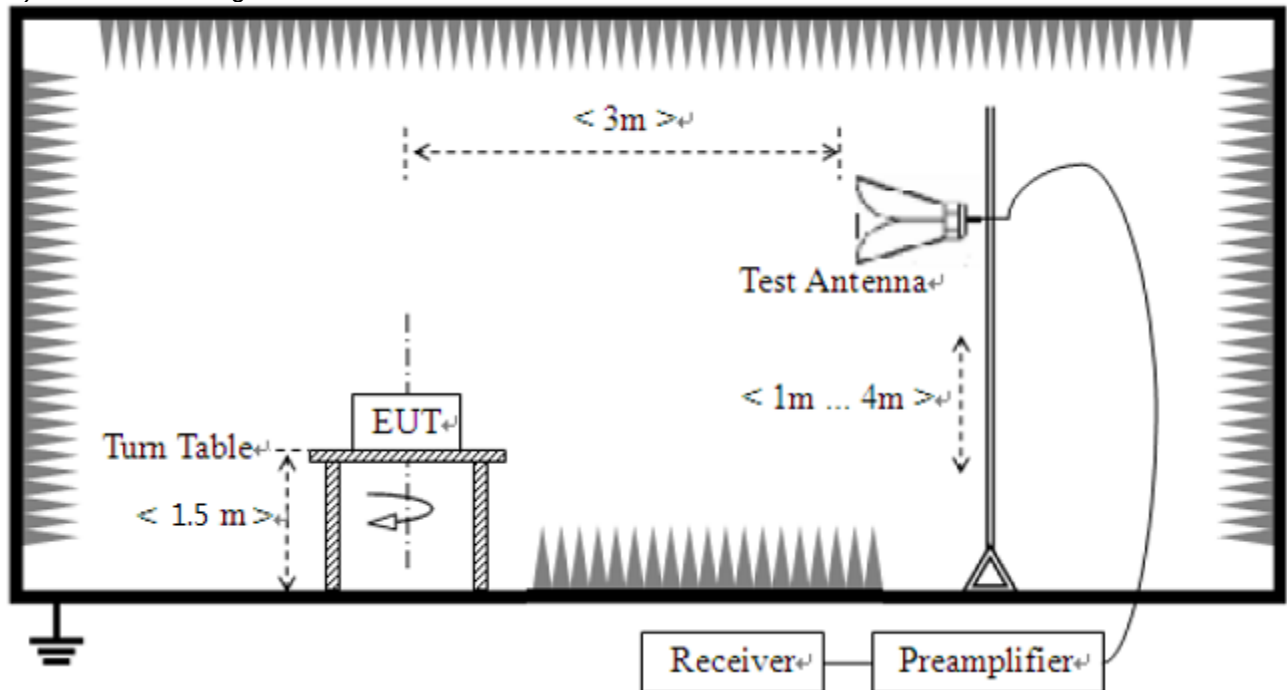

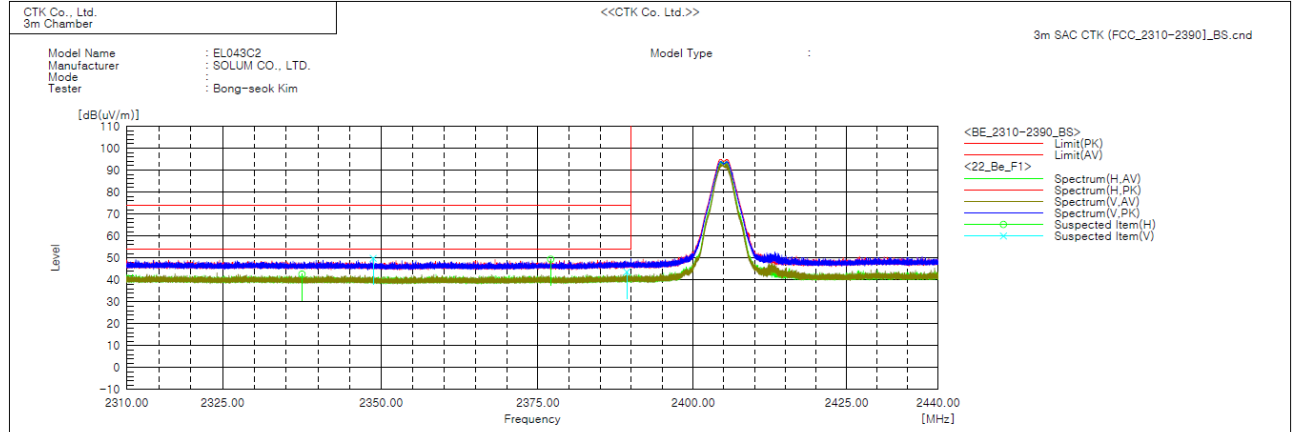

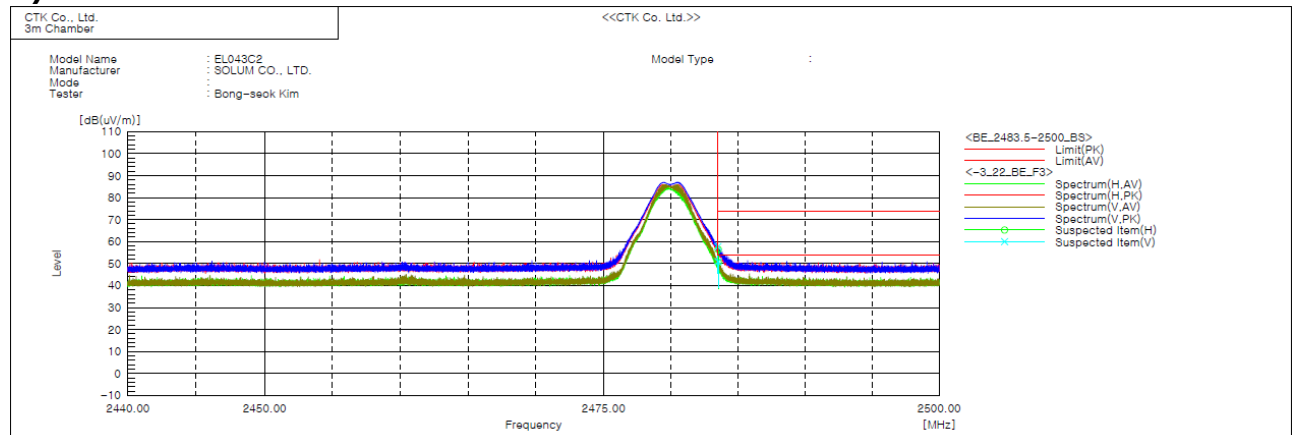


Restricted band edge test data

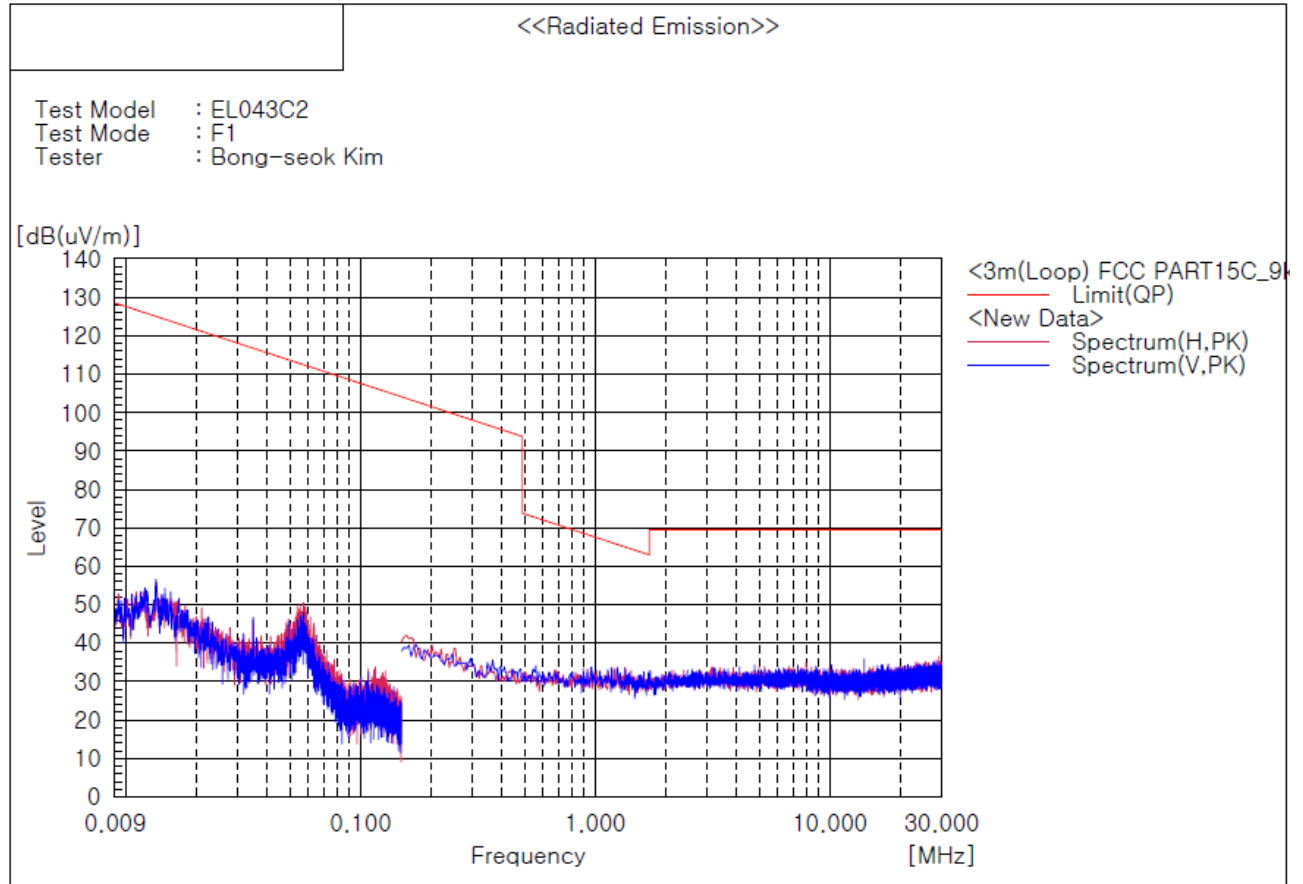

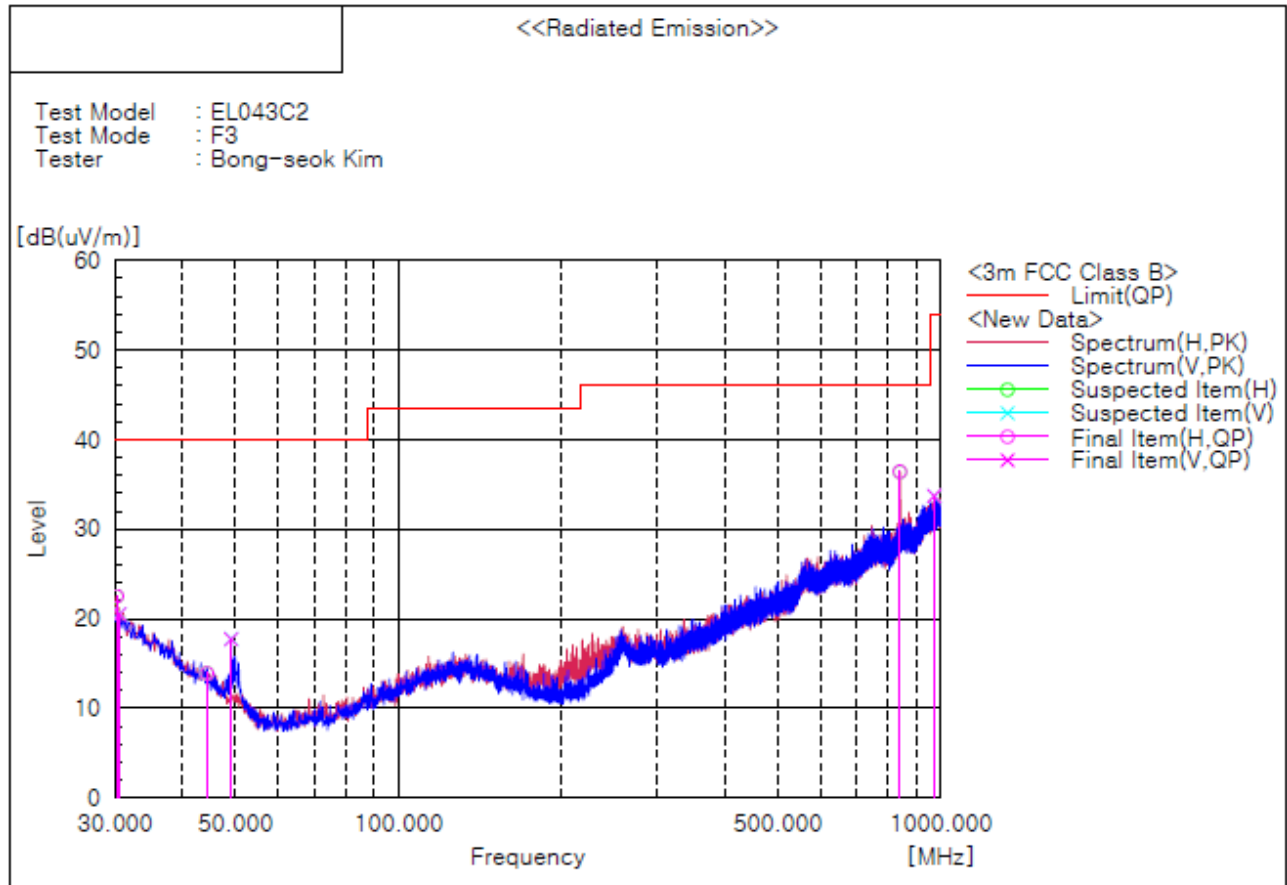

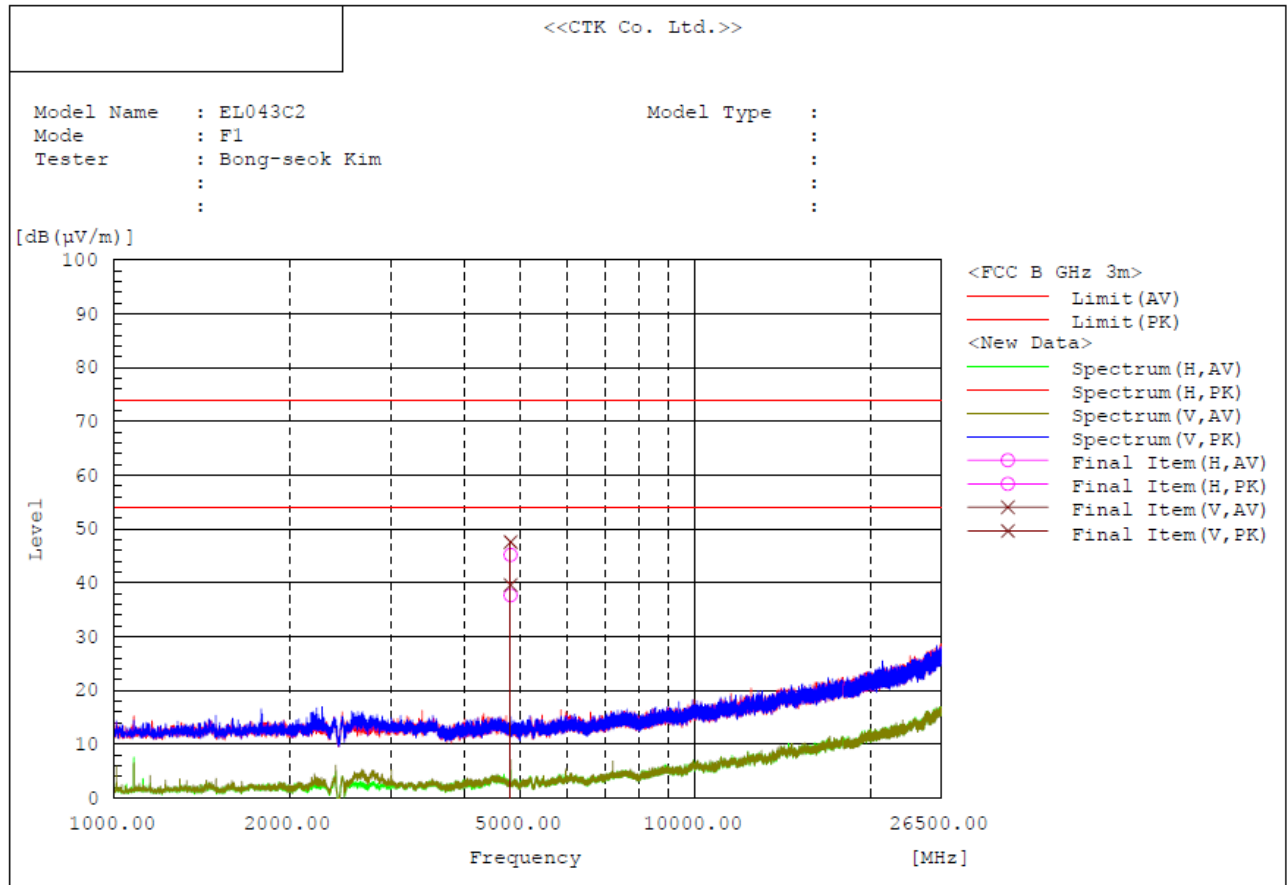
