I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1.) This tri band device has frequency bands of operation that are not applicable to the US. An attestation letter on Applicant's letterhead stating that this device is not capable of transmitting on non-US frequency bands is appropriate.
- 2.) Maximum measured SAR value in US PCS bands is missing from Manual. End users in this country are not familiar with DCS operation. Please modify.
- 3.) The Manual makes no reference to belt worn or holster conditions. This is acceptable, but unusual. Is this intentional or an oversight? Please confirm.
- 4.) The photographs appear to show a loop on the case molded behind the antenna. What is its purpose? If this is for attachment of a lanyard or wrist strap, additional guidance is currently being sought from the Commission for use of this feature. It may be advisable to caution users against use of metallic components, such as jewelry chains, if indeed this feature is for end users to attach wearable accessories.
- 5.) A Confidentiality Request letter is missing. Two POA letters were mistakenly uploaded. Please provide correct Confidentiality Request.
- 6.) The Tune-Up Procedure does not provide target RF Pout levels for this product. Please provide.
- 7.) The receiver associated with this transmitter which is licensed under Part 24 of the Rules should have the language of 15.19(a)(1) on the label. In general, if the device is smaller than the palm of the hand and consequently the label is too small, it is possible for this information to be included in the Manual. Please address.
- 8.) Please provide V and I through the finals as required by 2.1033(c)(8).
