

# User manual

## 1.Basic operation

### 1.1 Panel Operation



#### **POWER PUSH or PWR / Volume knob**

- When power is on, press and hold to enter the standby interface.
- When power is on, press to turn Audio off.
- Turn left/right to control volume.

#### **HOME button**

- Press to go to the home screen.

#### **RADIO button**

- Press to go to the radio screen.

#### **MEDIA button**

- Press to go to the available media.

#### **SEEK&TRACK button**

When it is pressed for a short time.

- Radio mode: Plays previous/next available frequency or station.
- Media mode: Plays previous/next file.

When it is pressed and held

- Radio mode: Plays previous/next available frequency or station.
- Media mode : Rewinds or fast forwards the file.

#### **PHONE button**

- Press to go to the phone screen.

#### **SETUP button**

- Press to go to the settings screen.

#### **Custom button**

- Press to assign a function to this button.

#### **Reset hole**


- Press with a thin object to reset the unit when it does not operate normally.

## **1.2 System ON/OFF**

The image of this product may be different from the actual product.

#### **Starting the system for the first time**

1. Press the Engine Start button. Once the system is turned on, the booting process will start and the safety warning page is displayed.



2. Press [Confirm]. If you want to change the system language, press [Language].

#### **Note**

- You cannot operate the system while it is booting up. It may take some time for all of the features

to be ready.

- The safety warning page is displayed every time the ignition is turned on. The displayed warnings are related to safety, please closely read and comply with the safety warnings.
- If there is no operation for 10 seconds in the safety warning screen, the system automatically switches to the last played mode.

### Turning the system off


- Press and hold Power button on the head unit.
- To turn the system on again, press power button on the head unit.

## 1.3 Main Menu



### 1. HOME widget

Long press main menu module or Click Menu->Edit Home widgets.



## 2. All Menus

Slide to the left.

**Phone:** Operates bluetooth hands-free and audio function.

**Apple CarPlay:** Runs Apple CarPlay function.

**Radio:** Converts to the last played radio mode.

**USB Video:** Converts to the last played USB video mode.

**Android Auto:** Runs Android Auto function.

**Favorites:** Click to enter the function of adding favorites.

**Climate:** Click to enter air conditioning settings.


**Media :** Converts to the last played USB music mode.

**Voice Memo:** Enter recording mode.

**Setup:** Enter the settings menu.

### 1.3.1 Reorder All Menu Icons

1. Press [Menu] on the All menus.
2. Press [Edit Home icons] to enter the icon editing interface.



### **Modify icon position**

- Press and hold an item to drag it to another position.

### **Default**

- Restore the icon to its default location.

### **Back**

- Return to the superior interface.

### **Home**

- Return to the Main Menu.

### **Menu**

- Choice [Edit Home Widgets] function.

### 2.1 Phone

#### 2.1.1 Function descriptions

This system provides the function as follows: listening to your telephone calls on the car speakers, play audio data stored in a Bluetooth audio player.


#### 2.1.2 Phone operations


##### 2.1.2.1 Bluetooth Functions

Click [Phone] button to Bluetooth Functions, Click [OK] to Add new devices page

**Note:**

- Search for the Vehicle Name In your Bluetooth devices and confirm pairing.
- Figure 3 Setting in connection in setup, to manage Bluetooth devices.





Click [Add new]button to enter the Bluetooth connection interface, search for the Bluetooth name of the car on the mobile phone, and click pair.

You can pair up to 5 devices. Click the Connect button to connect to the paired device, and click the Delete devices button to delete the paired device.

**Note**


- It is possible to pair up to 5 mobile phones. In order to pair a new phone when there are already 5 mobile phones paired, you must first delete one of the previously paired phones.
- When the connection fails, failure message is displayed on the screen.
- When a Bluetooth device is connected, a new device cannot be paired. If you want to pair a new phone, first disconnect the connected Bluetooth device.

**2.1.2.2 Call logs**




The system will record the Dialed/Received/Missed calls data in the memory. You can touch one in the list to view its detail and make a call.

### 2.1.2.3 Favourite Contacts




Show favorite phone numbers.

### 2.1.2.4 Contacts




Swipe the screen to view the address book, tap the search bar to enter the search interface to accurately search for the number, tap the letter on the right to quickly locate.

## 2.1.2.5 Dialer



Enter the number through the dial pad, and then click the dial button to dial. If you press the wrong number, press  to delete one digit of the entered number.



### **Silent mode**

- Click on it to mute the unit.

### **Outgoing volume**

- Set the outgoing volume during a call.

### **Keypad**

- Click to pop up the keyboard interface, enter numbers.

### **User Private**

- Switches a voice call from the car hands-free to the mobile phone.

### **End button**

- Ends a call.

## 2.2 CarPlay

### 2.2.1 Connect CarPlay

Connect your iPhone by the USB connector. The system will automatically detect the connected device and the CarPlay button will be enabled for operation on the Main Menu screen.

### 2.2.2 Exit Carplay

Enter into other source or cut the connect line will exit CarPlay.

### 2.2.3 CarPlay Operation

In CarPlay, the button functions as follows:




#### Note

- The Bluetooth source of the machine is not available when the CarPlay is connected.

#### Connect wireless CarPlay

1. Press [wireless projection] setting in connection in setup.




2. Click [add new] to search for available wireless carplay devices. Press the cancel button to stop the search. You can pair up to 5 devices. Click the Connect button to connect to the paired device, and click the Delete button to delete the paired device.

## 2.3 Radios

### 2.3.1 Listening to FM

1. Press [Radio] on the mainmenu.
2. Press [Band] to switch to FM/AM mode.



#### FM/AM

- Click to switch FM/AM mode.

#### Menu

- Click menu to display the tuner menu window.

#### Favorite button

- Click the  or  button to save the current channel to the list on the left, go to favorites.

## SCAN


- This function scans all stations and plays only stations with good signal strength.
- Press [SCAN ] to begin the scan.
- Press [SCAN ] again to stop the scan function.

## SEEK/TRACK

- Press[ ▶ ]/[ ◀ ] to change the radio channel.


## List

- Click list to FM list ,Click [Station] or [Programme type] two sorting methods.





Click menu to display the tuner menu window.




#### Set number of favourites

- Click to enter the Set number of favourites, Set the upper limit of the favorite list.





The AM screen of the most recent listened station is displayed.




## 2.4 USB video

### 2.4.1 Playing USB video

You can play video files saved in a USB memory device.

Connect an USB device to the USB port, Press USB video button to enter the USB video interface, Playback will start automatically.



#### Pause

- You can pause the playing file.
- Press [ || ] on screen .

#### Play

- Press [ ▶ ] on screen to play it again.

#### Previous button

When it is pressed for a short time

- Press the previous button to switch to the previous video (playing progress does not exceed 5 seconds).

- Press the previous button, the currently playing video will restart (Play progress exceeds 5 seconds).

When it is pressed and held

- Rewind the currently playing video.

### **Next button**

When it is pressed for a short time

- Press a button to cut to the next video.

When it is pressed and held

- Fast forward the currently playing video.

### **Repeat**

- Switch the repeat mode of the song: Repeat All, Repeat Folder, and Repeat Track.

### **Info**

- Click  or [Menu-info] to show the detailed information of the current video.

### **List**

- Click to enter the video list interface.

### **Menu**

- Click to display the USB video menu window.


### **Return key**

- Return to the previous interface.

### **HOME Button**


- Back to the HOME widget interface



## **2.5 Android Auto**


### **2.5.1 Connect Android Auto**

Connect your Android phone through the USB interface. The system will automatically detect the connected device and open the Android Auto interface.

### **2.5.2 Exit Android Auto**

Enter into other source or cut the connect line will exit Android Auto.

## 2.5.3 Android Auto operation




### Note

## 2.5.4 Connect /Disconnect Wireless Android Auto



the rearrange icons interface.




### Close

## 2.6.1 Bluetooth audio


### 2.6.1.1 Playing Bluetooth audio

When Bluetooth is connected and has audio rights, music in the mobile phone can be played in the car through Bluetooth audio stream. If Bluetooth is disconnected when playing Bluetooth audio, the audio stream will be interrupted. For more information on connecting Bluetooth, please refer to the “Pairing and connecting the unit and a

Bluetooth phone” part.

### 2.6.1.2 Starting the Bluetooth audio

Connect your Bluetooth device to the head unit. Click the [Media sources] button in the [Menu] button to enter the rearrange icons interface. Select Bluetooth audio to enter the Bluetooth music interface.



#### Pause

- Press [ || ] on screen to pause the music.
- Press [ ▶ ] on screen to play it again.

#### Previous button


- Press the previous button to switch to the previous song.



When it is pressed and held

- Rewind the currently playing song.

### Next button

When it is pressed for a short time

- Press a button to cut to the next song.

When it is pressed and held

- Fast forward the currently playing song.

### Menu


- Click menu and the USB music menu will pop up.

- This interface displays all [Songs] in USB music.




## 2.6.3 Apple Carplay

When the Apple Carplay is connected, the reorder icons interface apple Carplay icon is highlighted, and clicking apple Carplay will enter the apple Carplay interface.




## 2.6.4 Android Auto

To play USB video when playing videos from other sources, in the media interface, press [Media] > [USB video] in the panel.





#### To stop voice memo



This menu allows you to set the sound position, For example, you can set the sound close to the driver-seat so that the volume is relatively lower in the passenger or rear seats.






### 3.0.3.6 Phone Projection

- (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
