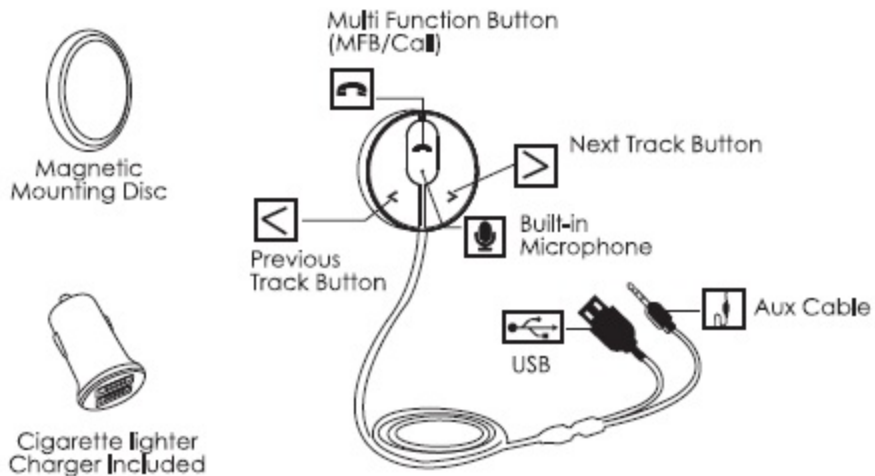

Product Feature

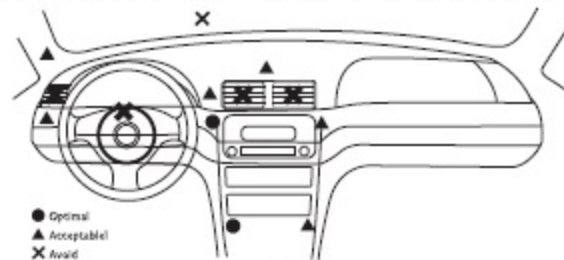

Installation

Caution: Do not place the BK01 car kit in positions that causes driving hazard or visual interference.

1. Locate a smooth and flat surface on the dashboard to install the magnetic mounting plate. Take extra precaution to ensure the car kit and the cables do not obstruct driver's operation or become the safe concern in any way. Recommended locations as following diagram.
2. Wipe clean the intended installation area.
3. Peel off the sticker covered on the back of the magnetic mounting disc

and attach it to the installation area on dashboard.

4. Place the BK01 car kit onto the magnetic mounting disc with microphone facing front for optimal clarity. BK01 Car kit can be detached from the magnetic mounting disc when needed.

Connecting to the power source & Audio output

1. Plug the USB charging cable to the car charger adapter and plug the adapter into the cigarette lighter socket of your vehicle.
2. Plug the auxiliary cable into the auxiliary port of the car audio system.
3. Turn on the car stereo and set the input source to AUX.

Switching On /Off

- BK01 Car Kit powers on and off along with the ignition of the car.
- Press & hold the MFB for 5 seconds to turn BK01 car kit on or off.
- BK01 Car Kit will automatically enter into pairing mode when power on, red and blue LED light flashes alternately.

NOTE: In some vehicles, power is supplied to the 12V accessory port even after the vehicle is off and the key has been removed. In such cases, the BK01 will continue to consume minimal power. Users may unplug the cigarette lighter plug manually to avoid any power drain at all.

Pairing

1. Turn on the car kit to enter pairing mode automatically. The LED indicator will flash in red and blue alternately. Now BK01 is ready for pairing.
2. Activate the bluetooth feature on the mobile phone and set the media device to 'search for' or "add" new bluetooth devices.
3. Select "BK01" from the list of found devices to pair. If applicable, enter '0000' as passkey.
4. LED indicator will turn to solid blue when connection is completed.
5. If pairing fails, remove the excessive unused Bluetooth devices from a list of paired devices and re-start the pairing process from step 1.

Note:

- If the BK01 car kit is disconnected with the paired Mobile phone, it will enter into pairing mode again. If no connection in 10 minutes, it will shut down automatically.
- BK01 Car Kit recognizes the previous paired device and will re-connect when it's powered on.

Factory Reset

- **WARNING:** Performing a factory reset on the BK01 will delete any previous pairings and will restore the unit to factory default settings. Only perform this if you are experiencing any issues with the product.
- Press and hold both Previous Track and Next Track buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds, then the BK01 will enter into pairing mode (the LED indicator will flash in red and blue alternatively.)

- **Note:** After factory reset, you will need to remove the previous Bk01 pairing from your Bluetooth device and repeat the pairing process.

Siri or Voice Command

In the standby mode, press & hold the "Next Track" button for 2 seconds to activate the voice command function on Android or iOS devices. Refer to the phone manual for detailed instruction if applicable.

Managing Phone Calls

- Adjust the call volume directly from the car audio system or from the phone device.
- Answer/End call: Briefly press MFB.
- Reject incoming call: Press and hold MFB for 2 seconds.
- Redial the last number: Double click the MFB.
- Mute/Unmute: Press and hold the Previous Track button for 2 seconds.

- Transfer calls between BK01 car kit and phone: Press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds in the calling.

Music Control

- Play/Pause music: Briefly press MFB.
- Play next/previous song: Press Next Track /Previous Track Button in the music.

Adjust Volume

- In order to adjust the volume please use your phone/audio player and/or the car stereo volume controls.

Multi-Point Connectivity

1. Disconnect BK01 car kit from the first paired mobile phone by disable the bluetooth function on the mobile phone. BK01 Car kit will enter into the pairing mode again automatically.

2. Enable the bluetooth feature on the 2nd mobile phone & search for BK01 car kit and pair.
3. Enable the bluetooth feature on the first paired Mobile phone. BK01 Car kit will be connected with both mobile phones now.

Note: The device which was active or used last time will act as primary device. Most functions like call answering, re-dialing, voice command would be done from the last active or used device.

BK01 will get auto connected only with second paired device. You would have to establish a connection with first device manually.

Maintenance and Warning

- Warning: keep the device away from children, the package may contain
- choking hazard such as mounting disc, stainless steel
- clip, or cigarette lighter adapter.
- Do not use the device if there is any water damage as it may cause short circuit or electric shocks.

LED Indicator

Power on (standby with connection)	Solid Blue
Bluetooth music streaming	Solid Blue
Pairing mode	Flashes in red.& blue alternatively
Incoming call	Flashes in blue every second
Active call	Flashes in blue every 7 seconds

FAQ

Q: The receiver does not turn on after starting my car.

- Make sure the USB cable is plugged into the car charger
- Make sure the car charger is connected to cigarette lighter

Q: I am having trouble pairing and connecting to my device.

- Make sure your device supports A2DP

- Check if the receiver is in pairing mode (Flashes in red.& blue alternatively).
- Take your device closer to the receiver and make sure your device is into pairing mode.
- If your device is asking for a "PIN" or "Code", please enter "0000"

Q: I cannot hear any music from my sound system.

- Make sure the receiver is connected well with your car audio system via AUX input
- Check your sound system settings to ensure that you have selected "AUX" or "Line-in" setting
- Volume is at an audible level on both your audio device and on your sound system
- Please check your audio device is playing music through connection

Q: The music sometimes cuts off while playing.

- Make sure your phone/music player is in direct line of sight from the receiver.

Q: There is a delay in the music.

- A variable delay exists between when the music is played on your device and when you hear the sound from speakers. This is completely normal.

Q: Can I power the receiver using another charger/power source?

- We recommend using the car charger inside the package to power the receiver.

Q: Why do I hear an electrical humming noise in my car while using BK01?

- Some cars have an electrical humming noise that is caused by the electrical system of the cars. To eliminate the noise, we recommend that you use a 3.5mm ground loop isolator.

Q: Why does the audio from my connected device sound choppy after BK01 is powered on (for the first 30 seconds).

- The BK01 has a Multipoint feature that automatically connects to 2 devices via Bluetooth. This feature will search roughly within 30 sec for the 2nd device if a 2nd device has been paired/connected on this unit. The choppy audio is the result of this search operation. You should experience regular audio beyond the first 30 seconds (once the search is completed).

Q: How to factory reset the unit?

- Press and hold both Previous Track and Next Track buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds, then the BK01 will enter into pairing mode (the LED indicator will flash in red and blue alternatively) - meaning the unit has been reset.

NOTE: This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation.
