I . Programming the Remote into the Alarm System

II. Changing Panic Operation to Delay Mode or Instant Mode

<u>Note:</u> To use this feature you must have programmed button 4 into the alarm panel as "PANIC".

SETTING PANIC BUTTON INTO **INSTANCE TRANSMISSION MODE**

1. Press all 4 button at the same time until the LED begins to flash. (This will take approximately 3 seconds before LED flashes.)

2. Release all 4 buttons

- 3. Press Button 1 (TOP LEFT BUTTON)
 4. LED should stop flashing

SETTING PANIC BUTTON FOR DELAY TRANSMISSION MODE (You must hold down panic for 3 seconds

before transmission is sent)

- 1. Press all 4 button at the same time until the LED begins to flash. (This will take approximately 3 seconds before LED flashes.)
- 2. Release all 4 buttons
- 3. Press Button 2 (TOP RIGHT BUTTON)
 4. LED should stop flashing
