**Handling guide**

1. Long press the **Power** button at the bottom right and the **Light** button at the top left for 5 seconds and power OFF device for 30 seconds.

2. Push the **Power** button and **Light** button together for 5 seconds and the device will power on.

3. Press the **Home** button to return to the home screen.

4. Press the **Back** button to return to the previous screen.

5. Press the **Mute** button to mute the device.

6. Press the **Volume** buttons to adjust the volume.

7. Press the **Channel** buttons to switch channels.

8. Press the **Source** button to switch sources.

9. Press the **Play/Pause** button to play or pause the video.

10. Press the **Stop** button to stop the video.

11. Press the **Next** button to skip to the next video.

12. Press the **Previous** button to skip to the previous video.

13. Press the **Full Screen** button to enter full screen mode.

14. Press the **Exit Full Screen** button to exit full screen mode.

15. Press the **Settings** button to enter the settings menu.

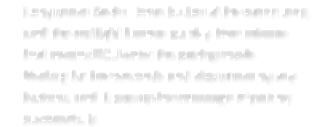
16. Press the **Language** button to change the language.
