

Statement

The compact flash card uses an already approved Bluetooth module inside (PNI8001001).

The Compact Flash card is intended to be used in PDA's, digital cameras (no transmissions during taking photos – held to face) and similar applications.

The application was tested in a PCMCIA card adapter inserted into a notebook. This notebook was used to set the device to the necessary test modes, which were used to set the device to the right channel, switching hopping on and off and to control the data stream to find the one with the highest emissions.

The equipment is a spread spectrum device, which has an equal occupancy of its hopping channels (79 channels in traffic mode)

It doesn't incorporate intelligence other than hopping to next channel when the transmission is disturbed.
