




The battery for the remote control (1 CR2025 Lithium Battery) is included. To replace the battery, push and slide out the battery door on the remote control. Replace the battery with a new CR2025 battery with the positive (+) polarity facing up. Slide the battery door back in to the remote control.

Remote Control

NOTE: The AR5100 remote is packaged with a plastic protection tab. Before operating the remote, gently pull the protective tab extending out of the remote control's battery door.





Mounting the speaker


Center Speaker: 1. Measure a width of 26.8 inches on the wall where you would like the Center Speaker to be placed. 2. Mark the position of the mounting screws on the wall

using a penci**l**. 3. Drill the 2 center speaker mounting screws (the larger screw heads) into the marks you have made on the wall and leave approximately 0.3 inch space to hook the Center Speaker on.

4. Place the Center Speaker onto the mounting screws. Make sure it is firm and stable.

Surround Speakers:

- 1. Mark the position of the mounting screws on the walls using a pencil where you would like your front and rear speakers. 2. Drill the 4 Surround Speaker mounting screws (the smaller screw heads) into the marks you have made on the walls and leave approximately 0.3 inch space to hook the Surround Speakers on.
- 3. Place the Surround Speakers onto the mounting screws. Make sure they are firm and stable.



Connecting a TV, DVD player, etc.

There are two types of RCA inputs on the AR5100. The first is 2-port left and right channel, the second is a 6-port 5.1CH surround sound. If your TV, DVD player, etc. has only 2 ports of audio output, refer to "2-Port Input" below. If your TV, DVD player, etc. has 6 ports of audio output, then refer to "6-Port Input" below.

2-Port Input (AUX)

1. Connect one end of an included RCA cable to your TV's, DVD Player's or other device's **Audio –OÚT** jacks on the TV, DVD or other (Red and White RCA output jacks are usually labeled **Audio –OUT**). 2. Connect the other end of the included RCA cable to the **(L)** and **(R)** audio input jacks on the back of the

subwoofer. 3. When connected to 2-port input, the input selection on the AR5100 will be AUX.

6-Port Input (5.1CH)

Note: Your TV, DVD player or other device needs to have 6 RCA output jacks for 5.1 surround RCA output. Your device's output jacks may be labeled differently than shown below.

1. Connect one end of an included RCA cable to your TV's, DVD Player's or other device's "Front Left" and "Front Right" output jacks on the TV, DVD or other (Red and White RCA output jacks usually labeled **FL** and **FR**).

2. Connect the other end of the included RCA cable to the **FL** and **FR** audio input jacks on the back of the

3. Connect one end of another included RCA cable to your TV's, DVD Player's or other device's "Surround **Left** "and "**Surround Right**" output jacks on the TV, DVD or other (Red and White RCA output jacks usually labeled **SL** and **SR**).

4. Connect the other end of the included RCA cable to the **SL** and **SR** audio input jacks on the back of the subwoofer. 5. Connect one end of another included RCA cable to

your TV's, DVD Player's or other device's "Center" and "Subwoofer" output jacks on the TV, DVD or other (Red and White RCA output jacks usually labeled **CEN** and **SUB**).

6. Connect the other end of the included RCA cable to the **CEN** and **SUB** audio input jacks on the back of the subwoofer. Be sure to match the colors correctly. For example, if the RED tip is connected to **SUB** on your TV make sure the other RED tip is connected to **SUB** on the back of the subwoofer.

7. When connected to 6-port input, the input selection on the AR5100 will be **5.1CH**.







Playing music wirelessly

Playing music

To enjoy listening to music wirelessly on your AR5100, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth enabled device. Once connected, press PLAY on your Bluetooth device. After playback starts, you can control the music with your connected device or the buttons of the AR5100 (with devices that have the AVRCP Bluetooth profile).

Play/Pause

• Press the [**VOLUME**] dial in on the subwoofer or press the [STANDBY] button on the remote control to pause the music. To resume music playback, press the [VOLUME] dial on the subwoofer or the [STANDBY] button on the remote control again.


