### Setting up your Uniden AppCam 40PT

1. Open the Uniden One app. The app is available on Apple iTunes, Google Play and the Amazon Store.



2. Connect your mobile device to your WiFi network.

IMPORTANT Ensure you are connected to a 2.4GHz (802.11 b/q/bq) and not a 5GHz network.

3. Login to your Uniden One account.



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· You can register using your mobile phone number or email address.

 During registration, you will be sent a verification code either by email or by text. depending on what you registered with. Enter the verification code to confirm your registration.

 Once registered, you will see the "Device" page.



2. Plug power cord into camera and wait approximately 30 seconds for the camera to power up. The light on the front will change from red to blue and the camera will say "Ready for WiFi Connection"



3. On the device manager page, click "Add Device". Scan the QR code with the mobile app.



### 4. The app should say "The device is offline."

5. Click "Connect to a Network", Input your WiFi password or connect wired connection if using a wired ethernet cable.



### Add Camera to Network

1. Input your WiFi password and click "Next". Wait for the app to register the AppCam 40PT camera to the network.



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### **Using your Uniden AppCam 40PT**

1. After setup, go back to the device screen by clicking "Uniden One" in the footer of the app.





Drill two screw holes according to the drill template if you use expansion screws.




