

1. Overview of I/O port:



- 1.1 Item list:
 - 1. Battery door
 - 2. Aux in
 - 3. TF card
 - 4. Lineout of Decoy
 - 5. Power Button

2 Operation Guide:

- 2.1 Open Battery door. Connect the cable of special battery. Close Battery door.
- 2.2 Push Power Button to Turn on the Speaker.
- 2.3 Waiting signal from Remote control.
- 2.4 Hold 5s on Power Button of Remote to Turn it on.



- 2.5 Screen will list out COYOTE/SERNADE/RABBIT.
- 2.6 Press "HOT1"(for Top Dogg) or "HOT3"(for Horn Dogg) to connect Speaker.
- 2.7 The active speaker will be connected and screen shows it in black.
- 2.8 Press Menu Back to Main Menu.

- 2.9 Screen will list out Sounds/Expert Hunts/Settings
- 2.10 Press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to "Settings" and press "Enter".
- 2.11 Screen will list out Source selection: SD/AUX/BT
- 2.12 Press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to the target source. The Speaker will change the source automatic.

3 SD Play(Hunts Mode):

- 3.1 When select source on the Remote, press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to "SD".
- 3.2 Press Menu Back to Main Menu.
- 3.3 Press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to "Sounds". And press "Enter".
- 3.4 Screen will list out Speaker selection.
- 3.5 Press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to target Speaker. And press "Enter"
- 3.6 Screen will list out Sounds selection.
- 3.7 Press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up". Speaker will play the sounds automatic when it's highlight.

4 AUX Play:

- 4.1 When select source on the Remote, press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to "AUX".
- 4.2 Speaker can be play line in music per connect an Aux in cable.

5 BT Play:

- 5.1 When select source on the Remote, press "Arrow down" or "Arrow up" to "BT".
- 5.2 Speaker can be connect with a BT player. And then can launch your BT music.

6 TWS music:

- 6.1 Set one speaker in BT play mode.
- 6.2 Turn on another speaker.
- 6.3 The two speakers can be connect TWS automatic. And lunch BT music.
- 6.4 Remind: Don't build speakers TWS group, before Mobile phone(BT player) finish connect to speaker.
