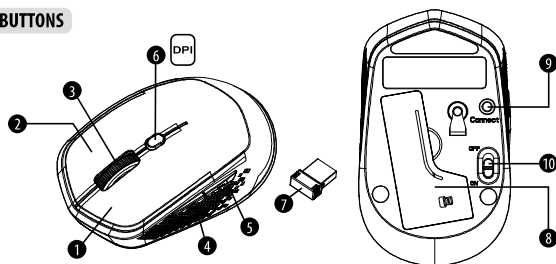

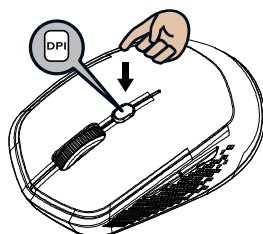
DPI Switch Key (Five different DPI)

b) Default is 1600 DPI

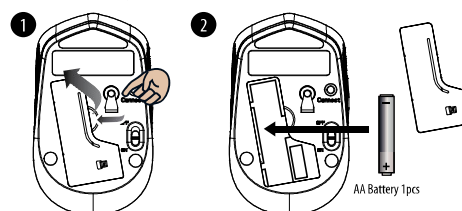


SETUP YOUR WIRELESS MOUSE

Step 2: Insert the batteries as shown inside the battery storage

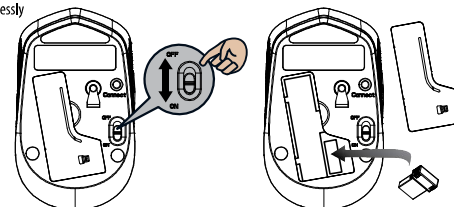
Step 3: Replace the battery cover
