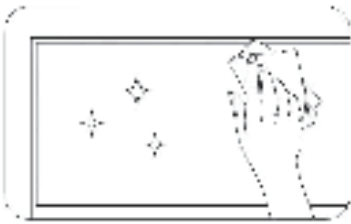


Installation Steps

- Before attempting to use the LED light bar please make sure that there is no dust, oil or fingerprints on the surface you are installing onto. For best results, use the included alcohol-based cleaning cloth to wipe the surface before attaching.

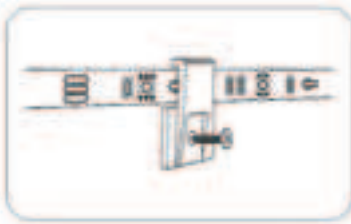
Peel off the protective film on the tape, place the strip on desired surface and press down firmly.

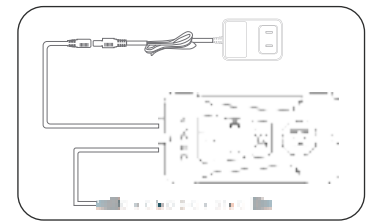
Reinforce via clips and screws provided.

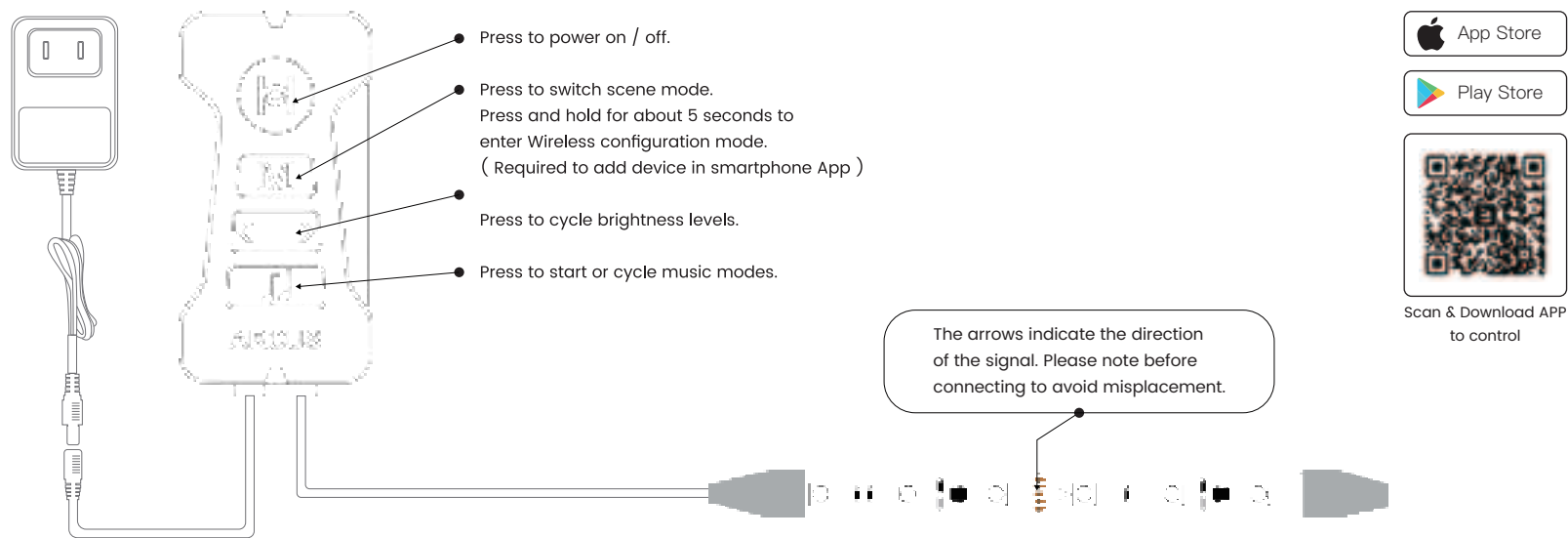


For corners, gently bend the strip over itself as shown above.
