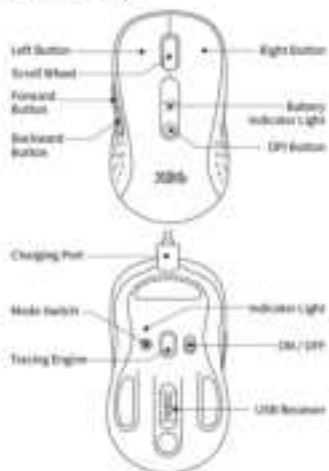

HOW TO USE

- **2.4G Mode:**
Insert the receiver at the bottom of the mouse into the computer, turn on the switch, and press the "Mode" button; the red light starts flashing, and the red light stops flashing after the pairing is successful. (Red light = 2.4G)
 - **Bluetooth Mode:**
Bluetooth 5.0 mode (blue light flashing); Bluetooth 4.0 mode (green light flashing)
- Turn on the switch and press the "Mode" button; the power indicator light flashes (Bluetooth 5.0: blue light; Bluetooth 4.0: green light), indicating that the mouse is in pairing mode.
Search for "B15" mouse or "B15 pro Mouse" through the device, and press pairing; the indicator light goes out after pairing is successful, and the mouse can be used normally.

TIPS PLEASE NOTE

1. This mouse can generally be fully charged in 2-4 hours and used for about 1 month after full charging. (Battery life depends on different usage situations and the device.)
2. The left and right buttons are multi-functional, including side keys and scroll wheel.
3. The mouse is shipped with a protective film on non-slip parts, please remove it before use.
4. Please note that our mouse is equipped with one specific USB receiver. Please keep it well.
5. The mouse cannot be used as a wired mouse.
