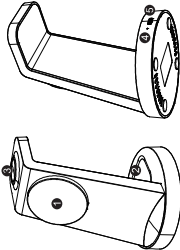

3 in 1 Magnetic Wireless Charger

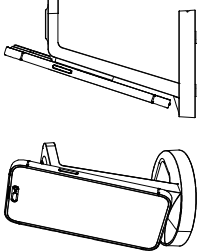
1. Introduction:

- Magnetic Wireless charging area for double phone.
- Wireless charging area for Bluetooth headset.
- Wireless charging area for smart watch or fitness.
- Qi Type-C Form.

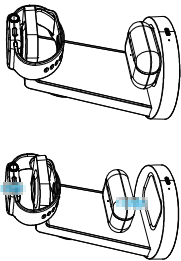


2. Operation instructions:

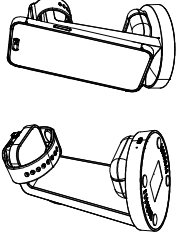
- 2.1 Charging the mobile phone: Put the mobile phone on the magnetic wireless charging area and once it starts a power indicator on the mobile phone, that is to say the charging is normally.



- 2.2 Charging the Watch: Put the watch on the wireless charging area of the watch, and align with the magnetic line. The Charging indicator on the Watch will light up, indicating that it is being charged.



- 2.3 Charging for Headset: Put the headset flat on the wireless charger area and see that the charging indicator of the Bluetooth headset lights up, indicating that charging is normal.



- 2.4 This product needs to be powered by an adapter with a power of 10W/2A and connected to the type-c port. When the button power indicator is on, it means that the power is on.
- 2.5 Operating indicator: The blue indicator lights up when charging, or all, and turns off when not charging. Indicator light flashes during charging fault.

4. Matters needing attention

- 4.1 When charging the device, do not use a protective cover with a thickness of more than 3mm, and do not use a metal case.
- 4.2 Do not put metal foreign objects in the charging area.
- 4.3 When charging, please turn the device at the center of the charging area.
