Using the wirelss charger

- Connect the included USB-C charging cable to the USB-C port on back of the charging base.
- Plug the other end of the charging cable into an appropriate power source.
- Place your wireless charging enabled device over the center of the charging pad with your screen facing up. Your phone or watch will automatically magnetize to the charging surface and the green light will change to blue upon successful connection.
- Place your wireless charging enabled earbuds on the base pad of your charger. The green light will change to blue upon successful connection.
- Phone cases or other accessories on the back of your phone may need to be removed in order create a strong charging connection.
- If the blue light is flashing, there is not enough power supply to the charger. Please use a proper power source to power your wireless charger.
- Now you're all set for a clutter free charging space!
