

How To Insert the Battery


- 1. Turn the switches located on both the car and the controller to the "OFF" position. (if has switch)
- 2. Open the battery cover using a crosshead screwdriver.
- 3.Insert the batteries follow the picture below.
- 4.Close the battery compartment.

How To Play


- 1. Turn the switches located on both the car and the controller to the "ON" position.

- 3. When your R/C model car begins to lose performance power or function it may be time to charge the batteries!




Basic operation picture showing how to use this product




Two rockers of remote control are pushed upward and the car moves forward.

The left rocker of the remote control is pulled down, the right rockers is pushed upward and the car spins around.




Two rockers of remote control are pushed upward and the car moves forward. The left rocker is pulled down and the left wheel rolls forward.

- 10. Rechargeable abtteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.


Care and Maintenance
