Pursuant to the provisions of CFR§15.212 Modular transmitters and KDB 996369 D01 Module Certification Guide v01r04, we hereby provide the following statement:

i	The radio elements of the modular transmitter must		Y

	(A) If using a permanently affixed label, the modular		
	transmitter must be labeled with its own FCC		
	identification number, and, if the FCC identification		
	number is not visible when the module is installed		
	inside another device, then the outside of the device		
	into which the module is installed must also display a		
	label referring to the enclosed module. This exterior		
	label can use wording such as the following:		
	"Contains Transmitter Module FCC ID:		
	XYZMODEL1" or "Contains FCC ID: XYZMODEL1."		
	Any similar wording that expresses the same		
	meaning may be used. The Grantee may either		
	provide such a label, an example of which must be		
	included in the application for equipment		
	authorization, or, must provide adequate instructions		
	along with the module which explain this		
	requirement. In the latter case, a copy of these		
	instructions must be included in the application for		
	equipment authorization.		
	(B) If the modular transmitter uses an electronic		
	display of the FCC identification number, the		
	information must be readily accessible and visible on		
	the modular transmitter or on the device in which it is		
	installed. If the module is installed inside another		
	device, then the outside of the device into which the		
	module is installed must display a label referring to		
	the enclosed module. This exterior label can use		
	wording such as the following: "Contains FCC		
	certified transmitter module(s)." Any similar wording		
	that expresses the same meaning may be used. The		
	user manual must include instructions on how to		
	access the electronic display. A copy of these		
	instructions must be included in the application for		
	equipment authorization.		
vii	(vii) The modular transmitter must comply with any	Y	
	specific rules or operating requirements that		
	ordinarily apply to a complete transmitter and the		
	manufacturer must provide adequate instructions		
	along with the module to explain any such		
	requirements. A copy of these instructions must be		
	included in the application for equipment		
<u> </u>	authorization.		
viii	(viii) The modular transmitter must comply with any	Y	
	applicable RF exposure requirements in its final		
	configuration.		

A **limited single modular approval** may be granted for single or split modular transmitters that do not comply with all of the above requirements, *e.g.*, shielding, minimum signaling amplitude, buffered modulation/data inputs, or power supply regulation, if the manufacturer can demonstrate by alternative means in the application for equipment authorization that the modular transmitter meets all the applicable Part 15 requirements under the operating conditions in which the transmitter will be used. Limited modular approval also may be granted in those instances where compliance with RF exposure rules is demonstrated only for particular product configurations. The applicant for certification must state how control of the end product into which the module will be installed will be maintained such that full compliance of the end product is always ensured.
