Thank you for purchasing the Vivitar Wireless Mouse with USB-A Wireless Receiver, item WM-ES45-RS. A USB-A receiver is included inside of your mouse. Please read this manual carefully FIRST in order to get the most out of your mouse.

#### **INSERTING THE BATTERY**

To operate your mouse successfully, you must insert 2 AAA batteries (not included). To do so, follow the steps below.

- 1. Open the battery compartment located on the bottom of the mouse.
- 2. Insert 2 AAA batteries inside the battery compartment, making sure to insert it with the correct polarity (+,-) as shown on the battery compartment.
- 3. Once your battery is properly inserted, place the cover back onto the mouse.

For best results, always use new alkaline batteries.

#### **BATTERY WARNING:**

Do not mix old and new batteries.
 Do not mix alkaline, stand (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickle-cadmium) batteries.
 Batteries are not to be inserted with the wrong polarity.
 Exhausted batteries are to be removed.
 The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

#### **MOUSE SETUP**

To connect your mouse to your computer, follow the steps below:

- 1. Take out the USB receiver from the mouse's battery compartment.
- 2. Insert the USB receiver into one of your computer's USB ports.
- 3. Make sure that your computer is powered on.
- 4. To power on, slide the power switch located on the bottom of your mouse to the ON position, and to power off, slide the power switch to the OFF position.

NOTE: Certain models may not have a power switch. Models without a power switch will turn on automatically and pair after moving or clicking the mouse.
