
BACK



TF (MICRO SD) CARD

- 1. Slide the **OFF/ON** switch to the **ON** position.
- Insert TF (Micro SD) card into the TF (Micro SD) Card slot. Sound message "Play by TF Card" is voiced and music will stream automatically.
- Long press ►/+ or -/ ★ button to increase or decrease the volume.
- Press ►/+ or -/ ← to move forward or backward on your playlist.
- 5. Press **I I / >** to play or pause a track.

"AUX-IN" JACK

- 1. Slide the OFF/ON switch to the ON position.
- Plug the 3.5mm AUX-in jack to AUX port of the speaker and another side to the audio device (such as phone / computer / tablet / etc.).
- 3. You hear sound message "AUX mode"
- 4. Select your favourite song from the source device.

Note: While using AUX-in, all functions such as Skip Forward/Backward and Volume control will operate from your audio device.

Long press ►/+ or -/ to button to increase or decrease the volume.

FM RADIO

- 1. Slide the **OFF/ON** switch to the **ON** position.
- Plug the USB charging cord (included) to the DC 5V charging port of the speaker; this serves as FM Antenna as well.
- Short press **Mode** button until you hear sound message "FM mode".
- 4. Press ► II / > button once and the device will automatically search and store all the FM Radio stations.
- 5. Long press ► /+ or -/ ← button to increase or decrease the volume.
- 6. Short press ► /+ or -/ ← to change the FM Radio station.

BLUETOOTH® PAIRING

- 1. Slide the **OFF/ON** switch to the **ON** position.
- 2. You will hear the indication tone with sound message "Bluetooth" Mode"; speaker is now in pairing mode.
- Place the speaker and Bluetooth device (phone or music device) so that they are no further than 1 meter apart.
- Activate the Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth device (phone or music device). Please refer to the manufacturer's instruction manual to enable Bluetooth on your device.
- Select the speaker "Mini Speaker" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.

- 6. If required, enter the password '0000'.
- 7. Once paired successfully, you will hear the confirmation of indication tone.
- 8. If pairing is unsuccessful, turn off the speaker first and then re-pair following the above steps.
- Once you have paired the speaker with a device, the speaker will remember this device and will pair automatically when the device's Bluetooth is activated and in range.
- 10.The speaker will attempt to automatically connect to the last device it was paired with when switched on. If you want to pair it with a new device, please follow the steps outlined above.

MULTI FUNCTION BUTTONS

- Mode A long press of this button will reject calls.
 In AUX mode this button will be AUX
 exchange.
- -/IM In Bluetooth® mode, press this button to skip to the previous song. This does not work in AUX mode. Hold this button down for longer to decrase the volume
- ► In Bluetooth®mode, press this button to: Play / Pause / Answer / End / Cancel Dial.
- In Bluetooth mode, press this button to skip to the next song. This doesn not work in AUX mode. Hold this button down for longer to increase the volume.

TIPS

- Press Mode button to switch different functions of the speaker. Order of the functions is:
 Bluetooth*/ FM Radio.
- 2. Turn **OFF** the device when not in use to save power.

CHARGING

The speaker includes a built in rechargeable battery. It is recommended to charge the battery fully prior to first use.

Connect the USB cable to a computer or other USB charging port and the Mini USB plug into the charging port of the speaker.
