Getting the App

1 Download App

Tuya is available for both iOS and Android. Search for "SmartLife", "Tuya Smart" in App Store or Google Play, or scan the QR Code to download the App.

2 Set up router

The device supports only 2.4GHz Wi-Fi (5GHz Wi-Fi is not supported).

Ensure your router is set to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi and you have the SSID and password.

Note: Device supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network only.

The length of the Wi-Fi SSID and password should not exceed 24 characters.

If your device has trouble connecting to the Wi-Fi network, or if you wish to switch networks, press and hold the RESET button for 5 seconds to reset the device.

Registration

Note: The App interface may vary due to version updates. Please check the App Store for the latest updates.

1 Sign up

Open the App, and tap Sign up to register.

If you already have an account, tap Log In to access it.



2 Complete registration

Enter a valid email address, agree to the privacy agreement, then set your nickname and password.





Note: Before creating a new account, please read the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use carefully.

Add Device

1 Power on device

Connect the device to an outlet (DC 5V/1A) using the power cable.



Note: If the device is not in the red slow flashing after 30 seconds of turing on, press and hold the reset button for 5 seconds to reset, and then restart to pair the camera with the App.



2 Pair device to the App

a. In the App, tap Add Device or + > Add Device. Select the icon according to actual camera.





 Follow the App instructions and Ensure that your phone has connected to a fluentand steady Wi-Fi network already.



c. Use the device to scan the QR code displayed in the App on your phone. Place your router, phone, and device close together for best connectivity.



d. Complete the network configuration.

Installation

Method 1

Simply place the device on a horizontal surface where Wi-Fi singal is strong.



Method 2

Install the device to ceiling.

a. Pick a clean and flat surface.

Note: Make sure the wall is strong enough to withstand 3 times the weight of the device.

Do not stick the adhesive tape on the limewashed walls.

b. Fix the included mounting bracket to the clean surface.



c. Insert the camera to the bracket.



Live View

Note: The App interface may vary due to version updates. Please check the App Store for the latest updates.

Open the App to view live feed, take snapshots, talk, record videos, and use other functions as needed.



Monitor Using Tips

1 Pairing of camera and monitor

Power on the camera and the monitor, and they will automatically connect. If the connection fails, please follow the steps below to pair.

Bind the monitor and camera

Press the Menu button on the monitor, and select > Camera.

Select Camera 1 or Camera 2 which you need to pair.

- 2. Long press the camera pairing button until you hear the prompt tone.
- 3. Press the OK button on the monitor to start pairing.
- 4. If you need pair 2 cameras, please repeat step 2~ step 4.

Unbind the monitor and camera

- 1. Press the Menu button on the monitor, and select > Camera.
- 2. Select Camera 1 or Camera 2 which you need to unbind.
- 3. Long press the OK button to release the binding.





2 Camera switching method

Note: If you have added 2 cameras, the monitor will display 2 live views at the same time. If you want to set parameters or enable functions of one of the cameras, you need to select and switch to the camera first (the number shown in the represents the selected camera).

On the home page, press the button and use the **Direction** button to switch the camera between Cam1 or 2 if you have added 2 cameras. Select one camera you need and press the **OK** button on the monitor to enter full-screen viewing mode. And then you can press the button again to zoom in and zoom out. (Zooming function does not work when the screen is not in full screen.)



3 Rotate the camera

You can adjust the monitoring angle for better vision.

The **Direction** buttons on the monitor screen are available when the camera is powered on. Press the **Direction** buttons to rotate the camera horizontally and vertically for better vision.

4 Photo & video

Take a photo

You can take a photo when you want to capture an interesting scene of the baby. Press **Menu** button on the monitor, select and press **OK** to take a photo.

Record a video

You can record a video when you want to capture a meaningful time for the baby. Press Menu on the monitor, select **[11]** and press **OK** to record a video.

View the taken photos and recorded videos

1. Press the Menu button on the monitor, select and press OK to enter the interface.

2. Select the camera and date, select the photo or video you want to view and press \mathbf{OK} to enter preview mode.

* Press OK to play or pause the vedio in the preview mode.

* Press the Return button to the quit preview or return to the main menu.



5 Play music

You can play music when your baby needs to be soothed. There are various soft music to select.

Press the **Menu** button on the monitor screen, select and press **OK** to enter the music interface. You can select different music, change the music cycle mode, or adjust the music volume.



6 Feeding reminder

Remind you to feed your baby when you are too busy, or when you want to give your baby a regular diet.

Press the Menu button on the monitor, and select Feeding Reminder.

 Select on or off to open or close feeding reminders. You can set up to 10 feeding times one day. And when the set time is up, a feeding alarm will appear on the monitor screen.

3. Press **UP** and **DOWN** direction buttons to select between 10 time options, and press **OK** to start the time setting.



7 Smart care

1. Press Menu on the monitor and select > Smart Care.

 Press UP and DOWN direction buttons to select options between motion detection, noise detection, cry detection and alarm volume, then press OK to save.

 When set up one detection mode, please press LEFT and RIGHT direction buttons to change options, and press UP and DOWN direction buttons to adjust the sensitivity.

* You can select different sensitivity according to your needs. Low refers to low sensitivity, and high refers to high sensitivity.

 Select Reminder Method, press UP and DOWN direction buttons to select reminder methods (icon, voice). To ajust the alarm volume, you can press LEFT and RIGHT direction buttons.



8 Temperature and humidity detection

You can monitor the temperature and humidity of your baby's room in real-time. When the temperature and humidity are out of range, you will recieve the alarms immediately, so that you can take measures.

1. Press the Menu button on the monitor, and select > Temperature and humidity. Press UP and DOWN direction buttons to select options between temperature range, humidity range and out-of-range reminder, then press OK to set up.

3. Press LEFT and RIGHT buttons to change options, then press UP and DOWN buttons to change values and units.

In the Out of range reminder option, select to turn on or off the alarm when the temperature and humidity are out of range.



9 General settings

Set up brightness

1. Press Menu on the monitor, select and press OK to enter.

2. Press UP and DOWN buttons to adjust brightness.

Set up time:

Press Menu on the monitor and select > Date and time.

2. Press the direction buttons to change the date, time, and time displaying mode.

Set up language:

- 1. Press Menu on the monitor and select > Language.
- 2. Select the language you need.

Set up sleep mode:

You can set up sleep mode to increase standby time.

1. Press Menu on the monitor and select > Sleep mode.

2. In default mode(Audio off), the audio from the camera can not be heard after the display is off, so the standby time is long. In Audio on mode, the audio from camera can still be heard even after the screen is turned off, and you can choose the time(1,5,10,30 or 60min), but the standby time is shorter. In Always on mode, the monitor remains on unless the power button is pressed, with short standby time.

• Turn on and off status indicator:

If you turn on the status indicator, you can get the working status of the camera. You can also turn off the status indicator if you think it will affect your baby's sleep.

Press Menu on the monitor and select $\boxed{\mathbb{R}}$ > $\stackrel{\frown}{\longrightarrow}$ On (Or Press the Menu button, select >Light > Status light).

• SD card:

 Press Menu on the monitor and select ->SD card management. Then you can view the total capacity and remaining capacity of your SD card.

(Optional) You can format the SD card as you needed, but make sure that the important data is backed up.

• Upgrade:

You can upgrade your camera when the upgrade alarm appears. Or press Menu on the monitor and select > Device information to check whether there is an upgrade.

• Low battery alarm:

When the camera is low on battery, the low battery alarm will appear on the monitor screen. Please charge the monitor as soon as possible.



Camera

- Q: The device cannot be previewed properly?
- A: Check if the Wi-Fi network signal is strong. If not, it is recommended to place the device closer to the router or reset the device and add it to the App again.
- Q: How to change the Wi-Fi or update the Wi-Fi password for the device?
- A: Please delete the camera on App, tap Add and follow the steps to use the new Wi-Fi network to add the camera again.
- Q: Why I can't get the notifications with App?
- A: Please confirm that the App has been running on the phone, and the relevant reminder function has been enabled. Also, please confirm the message notification and authority confirmation of the phone system have been enabled.
- Q: Failed to access the live video, prompts offline?
- A: Please ensure the camera is in the power-on status: the camera network indicator should be on.
 - Check the Wi-Fi network is in good condition or restart the router.
 - · Try to move the camera closer to the router.
 - Delete the camera from Arenti App and add it again.
 Confirm the App and camera firmware are the latest
 versions.

- Q: Cannot find the pairing button?
- A: The pairing button is the call button of the camera. Long press the button for 3 seconds, and follow the step instructions of the monitor.

Monitor

- Q: What should I do if the monitor is stuck?
- A: Press the reset button located near the power port on the monitor, or long press the power button to turn on the monitor again.
- Q: How can I change the wallpaper of monitor screen?
- A: Press Menu on the monitor and select > Wallpaper.
- Q: The monitor cannot be previewed properly?
- A: Check whether the monitor has connected to the camera. If not, pair the camera and the monitor firstly.
- Q: Why the camera or the monitor cannot identify the TF card?
- A: Confirm whether the TF card is normally available and the format is FAT32.
