2. EVALUATION METHOD

According to 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v05

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances \leq 50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)] $\cdot [\sqrt{f}(GHz)] \le 3.0$ for 1-g SAR and ≤ 7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR.

Where f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation

3. CALCULATION

According to the follow transmitter output power (P_t) formula : P_t= (E x d) ²/ (30 x g_t) P_t=transmitter output power in watts g_t=numeric gain of the transmitting antenna (unitess) E=electric field strength in V/m d=measurement distance in meters (m)

BT Pt=0.2655mW

The result for RF exposure evaluation SAR=(0.2655mW /5mm) .[$\sqrt{2.48}$ (GHz)]= 0.084<3.0 for 1-g SAR

FM Pt=0.000012mW The result for RF exposure evaluation SAR=(0.000012mW /5mm) .[√0.1079(GHz)]= 0.00000079<3.0 for 1-g SAR

Simultaneous transmission between Bluetooth and FM transmitter [(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW) / (min. test separation distance, mm)] • [$\sqrt{f(GHz)/x}$] W/kg, for test separation distances \leq 50 mm; where x = 7.5 for 1-g SAR and x = 18.75 for 10-g SAR.

SAR=(0.084+0.00000079)/7.5=0.0112W/kg<1.6W/kg
