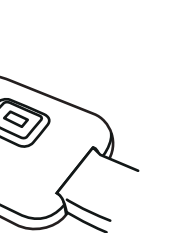

Go to the 「Device」, Click 「Add a Device」

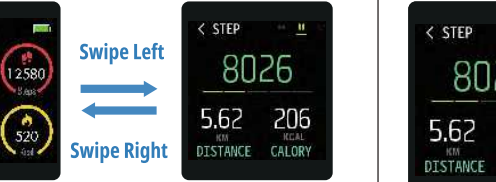
Choose your device on the scanning list

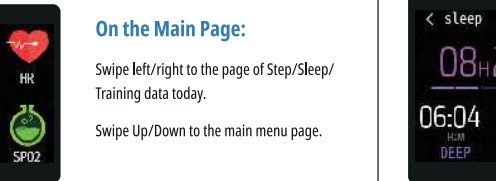
Long press the 「time page」 on your device, go to the detail

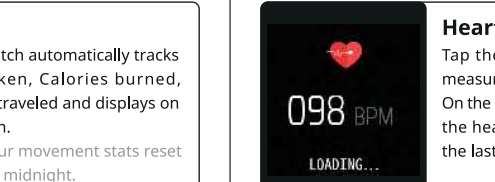
On the Main Page:

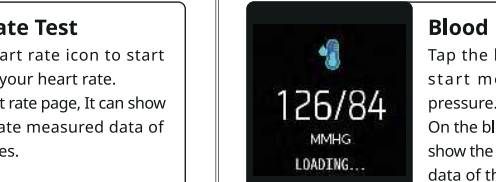

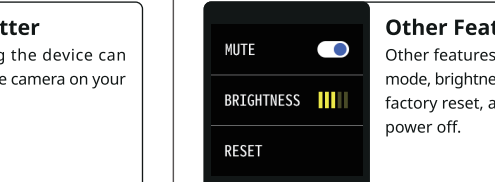

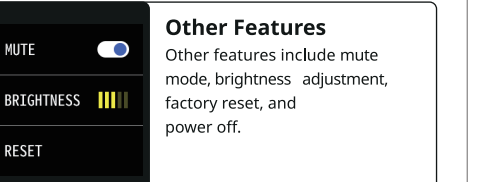

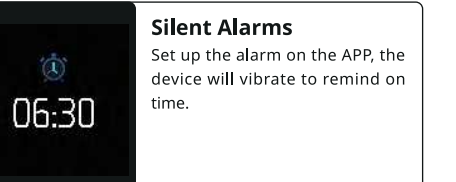

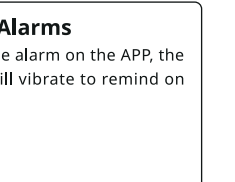
