The FCC ID number is as listed on the latest label: BCR-RPT-NODEC1937

A revided test report has been uploaded to correct the FCC ID number. Intermod proceedure is listed in the back of the test report.

All schematics filed with the original filing contained BOTH the 1937 and 1943 files and therefore can be used. The only difference between the two devices is the power level. This change consists of a "componant" within the unit. This componant has the same function in both units and therefore the block diagram will not change.

There are no signals within 15dB of the limit, as can be seen from the data, and therefore no reason to increase the resolution BW to demonstrate the noise floor of the measurement receiver complies at a higher resolution.
