To whom it may concern:

The following attestation addresses the requirements to support modular approval pursuant to §15.212 of the Commission's Rules:

The length of these lines shall be the length typical of actual use or, if that length is unknown, at least 10 centimeters to insure that there is no coupling between the case of the module and supporting equipment. Any accessories, peripherals, or support equipment connected to the module during testing shall be unmodified and commercially available (see §15.31(i)). (vi) The modular transmitter must be equipped with either a permanently affixed label or must be capable of electronically displaying its FCC identification number.	The modular transmitter is labeled with its own FCC ID number. Please refer to label sample and label location	
(vii) The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rules or operating requirements that ordinarily apply to a complete transmitter and the manufacturer must provide adequate instructions along with the module to explain any such requirements. A copy of these instructions must be included in the application for equipment authorization.	The modular complies with this requirement. Please refer to user manual.	
(viii) The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements in its final configuration.	The device complies with this requirement. Please refer to RF exposure report.
