

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging Instructions

Connect the USB-C cable to the USB-C port on the headphones. Then connect the other side to powered USB port (computer USB, etc.). The Red LED light turns on while the device is charging. It takes about 1.5 hours for the unit to fully charge. When the battery is fully charged, the red light will be off.

Turning on/off the device

■ Press the " "b" button for 2-4 seconds to turn ON or OFF the device with indication tone.

Pairing the device with Bluetooth devices (phone or music device)

- Activate the Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth device (phone or music device). Please refer to the manufacturer's instructions for instructions on enabling Bluetooth on your device.
- Once you have activated Bluetooth on your device, select the "QFX HP-E160" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.
- You can now start to use the device.
- Please note pairing mode on the device will last for around 3 minutes. If no devices are paired within around 5 minutes the device will power off automatically.
- If pairing is unsuccessful, turn off the device and try again.
- Once you have paired the Bluetooth Headphone with a device, the Headphone will remember this device
 and will pair automatically when the device's Bluetooth is activated and in range. You do not need to re-pair
 any previously connected devices.

FM RADIO

To play FM radio, press the Power ON/OFF/Mode button to change to FM Radio mode. Then, press the Phone/Play/Pause button and the device will auto-search and save FM radio stations in your area. For best radio station capture, plug in one end of the USB-C cable to the headphones. This process may take up to two minutes to complete. Once completed, disconnect the USB cable, and press the Next or Previous buttons to move the next or previous saved FM radio stations.

INSTRUCCIONES DE USO

Instrucciones de carga

Conecta el cable USB-C al puerto USB-C de los auriculares. A continuación, conecta el otro lado a un puerto USB con alimentación (USB del ordenador, etc.). La luz LED roja se enciende mientras el dispositivo se está cargando. La unidad tarda aproximadamente 1,5 horas en cargarse por completo. Cuando la batería esté completamente cargada, la luz roja se apagará.

Encender y apagar el aparato

Pulse el botón "U durante 2-4 segundos para encender o apagar el aparato con tono de indicación.

Emparejar el dispositivo con dispositivos Bluetooth (teléfono o aparato de música)

- Activa la función Bluetooth en tu dispositivo Bluetooth (teléfono o aparato de música). Consulta las instrucciones del fabricante para activar la función Bluetooth en tu dispositivo.
- Una vez que haya activado Bluetooth en su dispositivo, seleccione el "QFX HP-E160" de la lista de dispositivos Bluetooth disponibles.
- Ya puedes empezar a utilizar el dispositivo.
- Tenga en cuenta que el modo de emparejamiento del dispositivo durará unos 3 minutos. Si no se empareja ningún dispositivo en unos 5 minutos, el dispositivo se apagará automáticamente.
- Si el emparejamiento no tiene éxito, apague el dispositivo e inténtelo de nuevo.
- Una vez que haya emparejado el auricular Bluetooth con un dispositivo, el auricular recordará este dispositivo y se emparejará automáticamente cuando el Bluetooth del dispositivo esté activado y dentro del alcance. No es necesario volver a emparejar ningún dispositivo conectado previamente.

RADIO FM

Para reproducir radio FM, pulse el botón Encendido/Apagado/Modo para cambiar al modo Radio FM. A continuación, pulsa el botón Teléfono/Reproducir/Pausa y el dispositivo buscará automáticamente y guardará las emisoras de radio FM de tu zona. Para capturar mejor las emisoras de radio, conecta un extremo del cable USB-C a los auriculares. Este proceso puede tardar hasta dos minutos en completarse. Una vez completado, desconecte el cable USB y pulse los botones Siguiente o Anterior para desplazarse a las emisoras de radio FM guardadas siguientes o anteriores.

MODE D'EMPLOI

Instructions de chargement

Connectez le câble USB-C au port USB-C du casque. Branchez ensuite l'autre côté sur un port USB alimenté (USB de l'ordinateur, etc.). Le voyant rouge s'allume lorsque l'appareil est en cours de chargement. Il faut environ 1,5 heure pour que l'appareil se charge complètement. Lorsque la batterie est entièrement chargée, le voyant rouge s'éteint.

Allumer/éteindre l'appareil

■ Appuyez sur la touche " 🖰 " pendant 2 à 4 secondes pour allumer ou éteindre l'appareil avec une tonalité d'indication.

Appairage de l'appareil avec des appareils Bluetooth (téléphone ou appareil de musique)

- Activez la fonction Bluetooth sur votre appareil Bluetooth (téléphone ou appareil de musique). Veuillez consulter les instructions du fabricant pour savoir comment activer la fonction Bluetooth sur votre appareil.
- Une fois que vous avez activé Bluetooth sur votre appareil, sélectionnez le "QFX HP-E160" dans la liste des appareils Bluetooth disponibles.
- Vous pouvez maintenant commencer à utiliser l'appareil.
- Veuillez noter que le mode d'appairage de l'appareil dure environ 3 minutes. Si aucun appareil n'est apparié dans un délai d'environ 5 minutes, l'appareil s'éteint automatiquement.
- Si le couplage échoue, éteignez l'appareil et réessayez.
- Une fois que vous avez appairé l'écouteur Bluetooth avec un appareil, l'écouteur se souviendra de cet appareil et s'appairera automatiquement lorsque le Bluetooth de l'appareil sera activé et à portée.
 Il n'est pas nécessaire d'appairer à nouveau les appareils précédemment connectés.

RADIO FM

Pour écouter la radio FM, appuyez sur la touche Marche/Arrêt/Mode pour passer en mode Radio FM. Ensuite, appuyez sur le bouton Téléphone/Lecture/Pause et l'appareil recherchera et enregistrera automatiquement les stations de radio FM dans votre région. Pour une meilleure capture des stations de radio, branchez une extrémité du câble USB-C au casque. Ce processus peut prendre jusqu'à deux minutes. Une fois le processus terminé, débranchez le câble USB et appuyez sur les boutons Suivant ou Précédent pour passer aux stations de radio FM enregistrées suivantes ou précédentes.
