

MPE Calculation

Note2: To comply with RF exposure requirements, a minimum separation distance of **25.15cm** must be maintained between the antenna and the body of the user.

The MPE sample calculation for this exposure is shown below.

$$\begin{aligned}
 S &= \text{EIRP} / (4 R^2 \pi) \\
 &= 7943.283 / (4 \times 25.15^2 \times \pi) \\
 &= 0.9994 \text{ mW/cm}^2
 \end{aligned}$$

- Note

S= Maximum power density(mW/cm²)

EIRP= Equivalent Isotropic Radiated Power(mW)

R= Distance to the center of the radiation of the antenna
