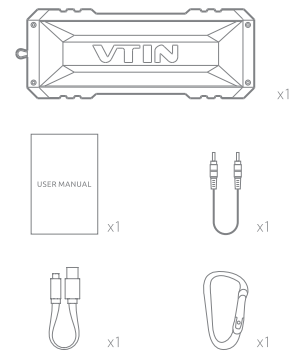

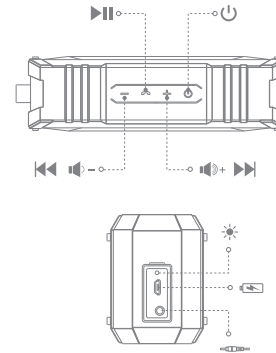

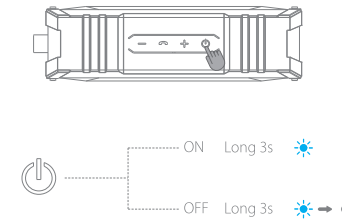
1. Package



2. Diagram

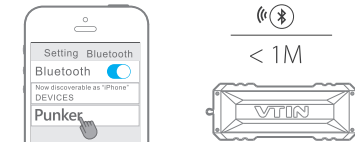


3. Power On/off

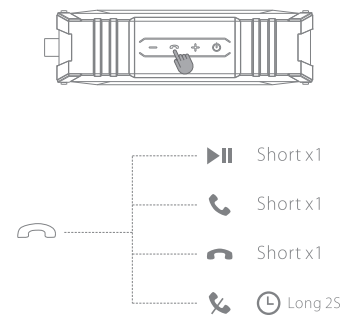

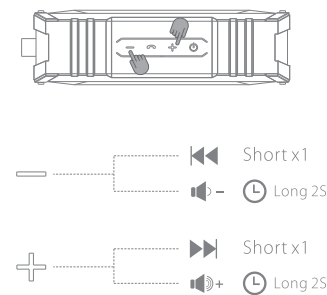

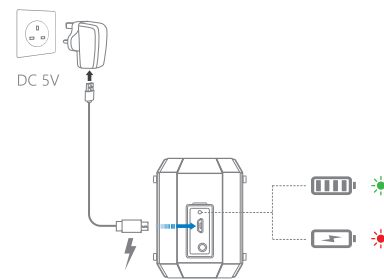

FCC STATEMENT
