




2.3 BLOCK DIAGRAM SHOWING THE CONFIGURATION OF SYSTEM TESTED

3.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- a. The EUT was placed 0.8 m above the horizontal ground plane with the EUT being connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN).
 - All other support equipment were powered from an additional LISN(s).
 - The LISN provides 50 Ohm/50uH of impedance for the measuring instrument.
- b. Interconnecting cables that hang closer than 40 cm to the ground plane shall be folded back and forth in the center forming a bundle to keep the cable above 40 cm.
- c. Excess I/O cables that are not connected to a peripheral shall be bundled in the center.
 - The end of the cable will be terminated, using the correct terminating impedance.
 - The overall length shall not exceed 1 m.
- d. The LISN is spaced at least 80 cm from the nearest part of the EUT chassis.
- e. For the actual test configuration, please refer to the related Item EUT TEST PHOTO.

NOTE:

- (1) In the results, each reading is marked as Peak, QP or AVG per the detector used. BW=9 kHz (6 dB Bandwidth)
- (2) All readings are Peak unless otherwise stated QP or AVG in column of Note. Both the QP and the AVG readings must be less than the limit for compliance.

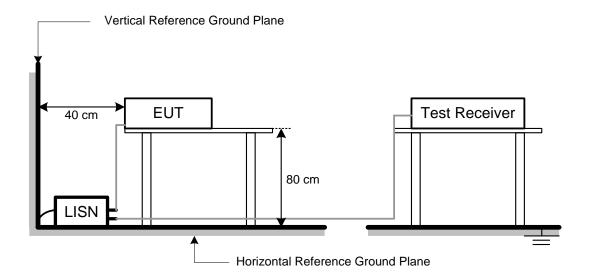
