Download APP: scan the QR code below to download and install. Register and login: open the "Smart Life" APP to register and login successfully. Then you can use it.

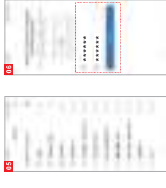


Add The Device-Scan QR code mode

- Make sure Wi-Fi is available and connected to the Internet.
- Open the Smart Life APP, press the "+" in the upper right corner of the main screen (Figure 01) choose "Security & Video Surveillance", click "Smart Camera" (Figure 02) to add camera, and then click "Next step" (Figure 03).



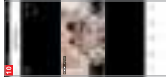
- Please note that only 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi network is supported.**
- If the mobile phone is not connected to Wi-Fi, please click "Connect to Wi-Fi" (Figure 04).
- If the phone is connected to Wi-Fi (Figure 05).



- A QR code will appear on your screen and you need to scan it with the mobile phone (Figure 06).
- After scanning the QR code, the prompt prompt will appear (Figure 07).

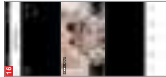


- Connection completed (Figure 08), and click "Done".
