









if any of the following conditions accur while using this product, it can be resolved independently,

1.Left & Right earbud can not pairing with each other

Take out the earbuds from charging case, two earbuds always flash red and blue or there are two bluetooth name of M48-ENC on the mobile

in the connection list of the phone or other bluetooth devices. Then 2 click the right earbud quickly, after 2-3s, both earbuds will flash blue slowly, that means they have paired with each other successfully

2.Only one earbud working

When connected the mobile, only one earbud working, and the other one flashes red and blue light, or no light flashes.

Solution: Turn off both earbuds, delete the connection record M48-ENC displayed in the connection list of the phone or other blustooth devices. Then 2 click the right earbud quickly,after 2-3s,both earbuds will flash blue slowly, that means they have paired with each other successfulli.

3.Earbuds can not be connected with mobile

1.Turn off the earbuds and turn off the bluetooth on molile, then turn on earbuds andturn on bluetooth on molile, to search the bluetooth name M48-ENC again.

3.Delete the bluetooth list record on mobile, then search M48-ENC to connect
