>Auto re-connection: The device and Bluetooth will find each other every time, so long as the speaker is set to Blueto and your device's Bluetooth is on. >Low power shutdown: Automatic shutdown when the power is lower than 3.3V

Time Adjustment:

Time Adjustment: Short press button "(***)" to adjust 12 hours by short press button "(+**)" and "(-**)". After adjusting hours, short press button "(***)" to enter the minutes setting. After correcting the time, short press button "(***)" to complete the setup.

Alarm Mode:

Long press button " ()" to enter alarm mode. Setting the time of alarm is the same as setting the time. Please refer to "Time Adjustment". (A small blinking bell in the upper right corner indicates that the alarm is being set.)

Snooze Mode:

When the clock alarms, short press any button other than button" (a)" to enter snooze mode. The clock will alarm again after 5 minutes. (When the LCD display shows the time and the alarm display flashes, the clock is in snooze mode)

Turn off the alarma Short press button "(==)" to turn off the day's alarm clock.

Cancel the alarm: Double click button "(str)" can cancel the alarm clock setting
