The Radio with FCC ID: PH3DJ-NX45T

This transmitter was designed to operate in following frequency ranges: 400-470MHz

To operate in the USA in the frequency range 406.1MHz-470MHz. the frequency ranges 400MHz-406.1MHz are disabled. Third party is not able to programming the transmit and receive channels.

To aid equipment authorization in other countries which accept the United States FCC Grant for Certification, Alinco Incorporated, Electronics Division is requesting that the FCC lists the frequencies 406.1~470MHz, under FCC Rule Part 90 on the FCC Grant.

Alinco Incorporated, Electronics Division attests that the UHF DIGITAL TRANSCEIVER will not be marketed to USA users with the frequency band which is not allowed by the rule part 90. Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operates on unauthorized frequencies.
