Power On/Off

Connect the wireless earbuds to your mobile device

Disconnect the wireless earbuds from your mobile device

Power off the wireless earbuds by:
 1. Press and hold the ON/OFF button (marked with a 1) for 3 seconds and the LED will turn off.
 2. Press and hold the ON/OFF button (marked with a 1) for 3 seconds and the LED will turn off.

Access / Forget a cell

When accessed, a cell phone will display the earbuds as a wireless network. To access the cell phone, press and hold the ON/OFF button (marked with a 1) for 3 seconds and the LED will turn on.

Forget a cell

To forget the cell phone, press the ON/OFF button (marked with a 1) for 3 seconds and the LED will turn off.

Functions

Power / Play Mode: Press and hold the ON/OFF button (marked with a 1) for 3 seconds and the LED will turn on. The earbuds will automatically connect to your mobile device and the LED will turn on.
