We have reviewed the Rockwell Collins application, Federal Communications Commission ID: AJK8221349, for certification. Rockwell Collins has assured us through measurements that their SRT-2000 INMARSAT AERO-I transceiver's spurious emission levels and intermodulation products in the band 1559-1610 MHz will not exceed acceptable levels. Rockwell Collins also stated that their system will have a priority and preemption scheme for safety-related messages. Therefore, we have no objection to the certification of this equipment.
