
- 1. The Speaker uses an all-inclusive performance audio reciever. This receiver features mutiple media capabilities to play all of your music all designed and has speaker proprietary built-in amplifier, for our woofers & horns for a complete all-around crisp sound and deep bass kick.
- 2. Your speaker pair features a heavy duty reachargeable battery that can play at maximum volume for up to 5-7 hours! At normal listening volume, your speaker will play up to 12 hours bet ween charges. NO DDD batteries to buy!

- -Auxiliary Port, connects to any device with a 3.5mm auxiliary cable (Not Supplied)
- MemCd ports for any pre-recorded music you may already have. Thimk demo tapes, mixes, etc...
- -Microphone Inputs. Comes with wireless microphone and TRS input jack for your wired microphone


- 1. Speaker uses a 4 OHM 10" woofer that emits a large magnetic field to ensure no damage to your computer or television devices please keep the at least 24" away from said devices while in-play & powered on.
- 2. The speaker comes with a 12V/12A rechargeable battery, if being stored please recharge every 3 months to ensure no damage to the battery.
- 3. If battery is damaged in any way please replace with same specifications for more information please goto our website for more instructions
- 4. Please avoid storage in high temperatures or areas of high humidity.
- 5. Do not overheat or expose the to devices that are over heated
- 6. Place your speaker when being stored in a highly ventilated area.
- 7. Please use caution when unplugging & plugging in your speaker device
- 8. Please refrain from use of $\,$ speaker while at low battery or while charging your

REMOTE CONTROL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. POWER BUTTON
- 2. PLAY/PAUSE BUTTON: Press the arrow keys to enter the desired track then press the play button, If you input the desired track and you are out of range it will continuously play the current track.
- 3. EQ BUTTON: The sound equalizer change mode. MODES: Natural, Rock, Pop, Classic, Soul, Jazz, DBB, & DRS WOW.
- *This only works for music played in MemCd Mode.
- 4.STOP BUTTON: Will stop the current track playing
- 5. MUTE BUTTON: Mute the current sound with this button.
- 6. PREVIOUS BUTTON: will play the previous track in the play list.
- 7. NEXT BUTTON: will skip to the next track in the play
- 8. VOLUME DECREASE BUTTON: decrease current volume.
- 9. VOLUME INCREASE BUTTON: increase current volume. 10. REPEAT BUTTON:

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

TROUBLE SHOOTING:

NO SOUND OR SOUND KEEPS CUTTING IN AND OUT?

- Please Make sure your speaker is fully charged. Another reason for sound cutting out is you are out of range.

I CANNOT PAIR MY PAIR TO MY SPEAKER

- Please try turning the Pairing off & then on in your phone settings. Then press the Menu Button on the speaker until the pairing is set, you will hear a chime and then another when you pair to your Device.

MY LED SOUND MOTION DISPLAY ISN'T WORKING

-Please move your speaker device out of direct sunlight. The LED display is as visible wiht UV rays from the sunlight.

MY REOMOTE CONTROL IS NOT WORKING

-Please make sure you have fresh batteries installed, or make sure you are aiming directly at the side panel. We use an IR remote so you will need to point at the side panel.

THE BLUE LIGHT WILL BLINK WHILE CHARGING. When your speaker is fully charged it will be a solid blue.

 MY VOLUME IS VERY LOW EVEN THOUGH VOLUME IS TURNED TO MAX:

-Try pressing and holding the >>button until it reads 30 in the red display box. This is the volume ovveride.
