Power Connection:

• Plug the alarm clock in using the included USB-C cable to a USB power source. Note: To use fast wireless charging, the product must be powered using a USB power adapter with Quick Charge 3.0 Technology.

Wireless Charging: • You can charge your smartphone with a protective case on it.

- (Works with most cases up to 4mm thick.) • If your protective case has metallic studs, magnetic clasps, or a magnetic plate,
- you must remove the case before placing your phone on the pad. • Also ensure the protective case does not create distance between the charging pad and the back of the phone that is greater that 4mm.

Charging:

- Your smartphone will automatically begin to charge when placed on the Wireless Charger.
- For optimum charging, place your mobile phone in the center of the Wireless Charger.
- When it's charged, the red light will be on. When fully charged, the light will be off.

LED Status Indicator:

No Light: Standby.

- Breathing Light: Device is charging properly.
- Slow Flashing Light: Foreign object detected. Charging is disabled.

- The wireless charger supports outputs of up to 15W (Fast Charging).
- To enable fast charging for your compatible device the wireless charger must be powered by a USB charger with Quick Charge 3.0 Technology (5V/3A, 9V/2A,

Ambient Light Settings:

- Press the Light button once to turn on the ambient light. Continue to press the Light Button to toggle through the various LED colors and lighting effects or to turn off the ambient light.
- Double Click the Light Button to select Medium LED Light Intensity.
- Double Click the Light Button again to select Low LED Light Intensity.
- Double Click the Light Button again to select High LED Light Intensity.

Power Button: Press and hold for 2 seconds to power the device on/off.

Bluetooth® Mode:
To enter "Bluetooth® mode", press the Mode Button and you will see a Bluetooth® indicator light flashing on the front of the speaker, proceed to your Bluetooth® enabled device settings and search the pairing name: MERKURY WCR01 and connect it to your device.

To control the speaker volume and track selections:

- Press the down arrow once to lower speaker volume; Press and hold the down arrow to advance to next track.
- auvarice to next track.

 Press the up arrow once to raise speaker volume; Press and hold the up arrow to return to previous track.
- If you don't hear any audio, press the up arrow to increase the speaker volume.

Time, Date, and Alarm Settings:

- Press the Clock button once to enter the clock settings mode.
 You will see the year flashing on the clock, press the up or down arrow to select the desired year.
- Press the clock button again to select the month and use the up or down arrow keys to select the

 In normal display mode you can turn the alarm function on or off by pressing and holding the clock button for 2 seconds.

 To switch between a 12H or 24H clock display; simply press the down arrow while in normal display mode to toggle between a 12H or 24H clock.

 To switch between Celsius or Fahrenheit Temperature display; simply press the up arrow while in normal display mode to toggle between Celsius or Fahrenheit temperature.
