# Welcome to Verisure

Congratulations, you have just installed the Verisure Smart Alarm in your home or business; an advanced security system designed to offer you maximum protection and, at the same time, ensure easy and comfortable daily use.

This manual is a tool that will help you get acquainted with the alarm system in its first uses and will serve as a consultation document in case of any questions that may arise about the handling of your alarm. If you have any other questions after reading the manual,

We encourage you to install the My Verisure app on your mobile or tablet. This application will allow you to know what is happening in your home or business at all times, remotely control your alarm system and access any settings.



# Description of the alarm system

## Smart Sensor motion detector S01-MD25-100A

Protects doors and windows. It has a triple detection system sensitive to opening, closing and vibration, which allows us to detect the intruder even before they enter.



## Motion Photo/Video Detector with colour camera and 2G S01-MD25-100C

They protect the interior of your home or business.

When they detect unusual movement, they take 10 images that are sent to our Alarm Receipt Centre, where we check in seconds what's happening.

**Voiceped S01-SV and Smart Keys** allows you to easily control and disconnect the alarm with the "at hand" of your mobile by presenting one of the smart keys, entering a command code or using the remote control.

The input reader incorporates speech/dictation system, which are a SOS button for emergencies.

## My Vensure App

Control your alarm system, monitor what's happening in your home or business, and contact Vensure via chat. Wherever you are, from your mobile or tablet.



### **Central Unit GOL-CU2**

Its function is to manage signals from all alarm devices and transmit them to the Verisure alarm receiving centre.

To ensure signal transmission, it has Ethernet, (4G), WLAN, 4G, 3G and GPRS network connection which are immune to frequency inhibitions.

### **Wi-Fi Extender GOL-WXND**

Its function is to extend the range of the Wi-Fi coverage and devices can be controlled and monitored over our proprietary radio protocol, over the 900Hz GOF-IDR.

### **Emergency GOL-Emer**

The emergency button provides the user with a discrete procedure to alert Verisure that an emergency is occurring, and you require immediate help. It's designed to be actuated immediately and correctly in the protected property generating a signal of 20dB visible so it prevents the thief to perform the burglary.


### **OutDoor Motion Photo/Voice detector GOL-MD-PV**

Guaranteed OutDoor with Verisure's own "click" protection service helps prevent intruder before it happens, by creating a double-line layer of defense. Monitoring outdoor events and acts if a potential threat is identified.

# Arming Modes

## WHEN YOU LEAVE YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS

### CONNECTION IN FULL MODE

When you leave your home or business and there's no one left inside, set the alarm to away mode with this arming mode. All detectors are active and your property is fully protected.

### DISARMING

When you access your home or business, disarm the alarm. This way you can freely access and move throughout the installation, as the detectors will no longer be active.

## WHEN YOU'RE AT HOME OR BUSINESS

### ARMING IN HOME-MODE

If you are in your home or business, we recommend activating the alarm in home mode to stay protected. This will activate only the detectors in the areas you configure, so you can move freely around the rest of the installation. Note: we recommend arming the partial mode as long as you're inside your home or business.

### ARMING IN PERIMETER-MODE

The perimeter mode allows you to activate only perimeter detectors,<sup>4</sup> so that the outer area is protected.

## Voicepad



- ① Disarm Button
- ② Arm Button in Perimeter Mode
- ③ Arm Button for HomeMode
- ④ Arm Button for AwayMode
- ⑤ Keyboard and KeyReader
- ⑥ Cancel/ Delete
- ⑦ SOS Button (Hold down until all indicators light up)

### TO CHANGE THE STATUS OF YOUR ALARM

Follow the steps below:

Click the mode that you want to activate your system in **①②③④** or Identify how you want to arm the system through one of the two options:



#### Option 1

Present your smart key by placing it in the centre of the keypad **⑦**.



#### Option 2

Enter your pin code


## Voicepad: Understanding the LED notifications

### Technical Notifications

The Voicepad will notify you of any technical information you will need to keep your system working optimally. When you have a notification you will see two Amber lights.


To listen to the notification, tap the microphone and then identify yourself by presenting your smart key or entering your pin code. Finally, press the "cancel/delete" button (<) and the indicator lights will turn off. The indicator lights will remain illuminated in yellow - until it is resolved.

**Note:** You can press the "cancel/delete" button (<) at any time to stop listening to notifications.



### Intrusion notifications

The Voicepad will notify you of any security information you have received while your system has been armed. When you have a security notification you will see four amber LEDs.



The numbers associated with the device(s) that have been affected will be displayed on the keyboard.

Finally, to confirm that you have been informed you must press the "cancel/delete" button(s).

## Remote Control




If at anytime you attempt to arm/partially arm and you have one window/door opened, the system will not allow you to do so and will be signalled by the light coming on in full mode and partial mode.

- ① Disconnect Button
- ② Connection Button in partial mode
- ③ Connection Button in full mode
- ④ SOS Button
- ⑤ Lock the Remote Control  
 Unlock the Remote Control

**SOS signal from your remote control**  
To send an SOS signal in case of emergency, press buttons 1 and 3 simultaneously and hold for 2 seconds.

- 1** **Alarm status:** the icon shows the current status of your alarm system. To modify it you can click on the icon or use the "Connect/Disconnect" and "Other Modes" buttons.
- 2** **Photodetector:** shows the latest images taken by your current detectors.
- 3** **Keys and controls:** show the last two events related to the keys and controls of your facility.
- 4** **Help:** facilitates access to our Customer Service channels to resolve any questions or incidents.
- 5** **Timeline:** displays all events related to your alarm system: status changes, alarm triggers.
- 6** **More:** Access all the features and settings of your alarm.
- 7** **Devices & Features:** Check and configure the devices in your installation.
- 8** **Invoices:** Check and download your latest bill.
- 9** **My system:** Control all your security system settings (code words, action plans, etc.)
- 10** **Help:** Access to user support, frequently asked questions and guides & certificates.
- 11** **Configuration:** Control security preferences, notifications and privacy.

# Codewords

Codewords are required for each interaction you have with Verisure. They serve to identify yourself (as an alarm holder) and Verisure specialists, ensuring maximum security in every interaction. We remind you of your keywords:

## Verisure Codeword:


We will use this to identify ourselves when contacting you.

## Customer Codeword:

We will ask for this to verify we are speaking to an authorised user.

Keywords provided to you at the time of installation are provisional... for your safety we strongly advise you to change them to something secure and memorable. We also recommend to update them overtime.

Go to the <More> section and click <My System> and <Code Words>. Click the < and edit code words> and follow the steps to modify them.



## FCC



