

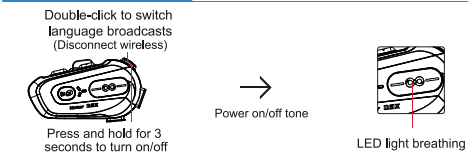

## Product Overview

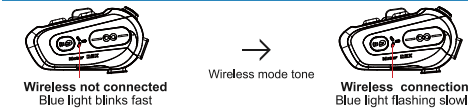


**Important Reminder:**

If there is a big difference in sound effect and volume after installing into the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker inside the helmet.

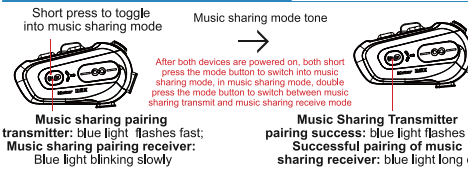

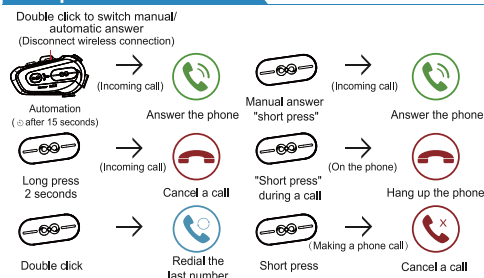

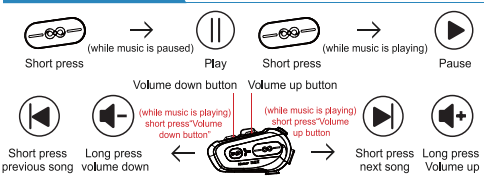

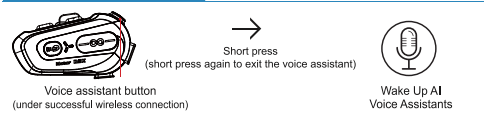

## Caveat
