



### Volume adjust

Press the 👍 or 💻 to turn volume up or down.

Once volume reach the maximum, power LED flashes three times per press.

# Power on/Power off


Press of for 3 seconds to turn on the speaker. The power LED stays on 3 seconds then turn off.

Press of for 3 seconds to turn off the speaker. The power LED flashes three times then turn off.

## Pairing


### Pairing one phone

- Turn on speaker, press and hold the for about 3 seconds, the Wireless LED flashes twice per second.
- 2. Activate Bluetooth on your phone and set it to search for new devices.
- 3. Select 'S1'. When the pairing is successful,the Wireless LED flash Wireless LED flashes once every 5 seconds.



### Pairing another phone

Multipoint technology enables you to pair two phones and take a call from either. To pair second phone, follow the steps for "Pair One Phone". After pairing successfully, restart the Speaker, the Speaker connect to second phone automatically, then press and hold for about 2 seconds to enable multipoint function, the Speaker connect to first phone automatically, now the Speaker connect to the two phones.



### Call

### Operating instructions

Press the II once.

End a call Press and hold the III for 2 seconds.

Mute Press the ≰ once.

Reject a call Press and hold the DIII for about 2 seconds.

Redial the last call Double–press the lin standby mode. The mobile phone will redial the last call number.

### Music

(Need media player support)

Music play / pause

Press DI to play / pause music.

Trackback / Trackforward

Press the = for 2 seconds to skip track back.

Press the for 2 seconds to skip track forward.

Switch Music and Call

When a call rings during a music playing, the music automatically pauses to allow you to answer or ignore the call. Once the call is ignored or ends, the music is resumed.

Mute
Press the 

substituting Mute on/off.

Press the EQ to switch to the inside mode or outside mode.

Use the 3.5mm audio cable connect the speaker and the equipment, press the  $\overline{\mbox{\sc aux}}$  , AUX LED stays on.

### Charging

It takes about 8 hours to fully charge the speaker. The Power LED stays on while charging and turn off once fully charged.

Note: The lifetime of the battery will be significantly reduced if the speaker is left uncharged for a long period. It's recommend that recharge your speaker at least or
