Cleaning of the Heads, Plinch Rollers and Capstans




- moistened with alcohol (methylated spirit) or special head-cleaning fluid.

- * Carefully rub the face of the heads and also the surface of the capstans and the pinch rollers.



USAGE METHOD:

1.MP3 and Bluetooth partial function operation:

- a. Switch to BT/Music mode, inserted card or USB to the card slot or USB jack, it will play the songs from the card or USB.
